By-law 19-037

General purpose for which Regional Development Charges are imposed

Regional Development Charges are applicable to all lands within the corporate boundaries of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo unless specifically exempted in the By-law. Development Charges are collected for the purpose of recovering, to the extent possible, the net growth-related costs of capital projects. Growth-related projects in the following service categories are included in the Regional Development Charge:

Service category:

- General Government
- Police Service
- Paramedic Services
- Airport
- Operations
- Transit*
- Library**
- Waste Management
- Transportation
- Water Supply
- Wastewater

* Applicable only in the Cities of Cambridge, Kitchener and Waterloo

** Applicable only in the Townships of North Dumfries, Wellesley, Wilmot and Woolwich

Determination of Applicable Development Charge

The calculation of the amount payable will take into account the schedule on page 3. Certain exemptions and discounts approved by Council or provided under the Development Charges Act, 1997 may apply. Please refer to the Region's Development Charge By-law 19-037 and the Region's Development Charges Interest Policy for additional information.

Payment of Regional Development Charge

Payment of all applicable Regional Development Charges is made through the municipal offices of the Cities of Waterloo, Kitchener and Cambridge and the Townships of North Dumfries, Wilmot, Wellesley, and Woolwich. Please contact the applicable area Municipal Building Department to determine processing times and application procedures for Building Permit issuance.

* Qualifying Industrial development that meets the definition of "Industrial Building" as prescribed by the Region's Development Charge By-law 19-037 is eligible for a 60 per cent discount to the Non-Residential Rate.

* Qualifying Office development that is in excess of 20,000 square feet (for the third floor and above) in an urban growth centre is eligible for a 50 per cent discount to the Non-Residential Rate (for the third floor and above).

*** - General Services includes General Government, Police Service, Paramedic Services, Airport, Operations, Transit Services (Cities only), Library (Townships only), Waste Management, Transportation
