

Region of Waterloo Oversize Load Permit Terms and Conditions

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo confirms that electronic signature for the Oversize Load Permit is acceptable provided that the applicant is specifically authorized by the Moving Firm to enter into and execute the Permit document in such manner.

Conditions for Approval

The following noted conditions must be met:

- 1) The applicant will ensure that the approved route is appropriate and available for all the proposed movements in advance of and on the day of each move taking into consideration items such as road widths, traffic volumes, overhead obstructions, the presence of any utilities or signal equipment and the possible need for their removal or relocation. No representations are made by municipal authorities as to the clearances and capacities involved therein;
- 2) If it is necessary to cross a sidewalk or curbing with the load mentioned herein, the applicant will cover said sidewalk or curbing with 10 cm (4") planking;
- 3) The applicant, his or her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns will indemnify and save harmless The Regional Municipality of Waterloo (the Region) and any area municipalities included on the Permit from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions and judgments made, brought or recovered against the municipalities and from all loss, costs, damages, charges or expenses that may be incurred, sustained or paid by the municipalities by reason of granting of the Oversize Load Permit. The indemnity provisions of this Agreement shall survive the termination of the Agreement;
- 4) Each of the municipalities noted on the Permit reserves the right to cancel its permission at any time without notice. Permission is limited to the date specified on this Permit. The road authority involved shall have the right to remove the load from the road at the mover's expense in the event of a breakdown or other obstruction of the road which is not in accordance with this Permit; and
- 5) The applicant shall comply with all municipal by-laws and provincial or federal laws including but not limited to compliance with the "Highway Traffic Act".

Additional Class 3 or 4 and Superload Permit Conditions

- 6) The applicant must submit a Certificate of Insurance evidencing the coverage below for the duration of the Permit. If applicable, the applicant shall purchase and maintain third party liability insurance acceptable to the Region throughout the term of this Agreement. Such coverage shall protect the Region and any area municipalities included on the Permit against all claims for all damages or injury including death to any person or persons and for damage to any property of the Region or any area municipalities included on the Permit or any other public or

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private property resulting from or arising out of any act or omission on the part of the applicant or any of his or her servants or agents, during the time that the applicant is moving along or across any Regional Road or area municipal road named on the Permit. Coverage shall consist of a comprehensive policy of public liability and property damage insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence. Such insurance shall name the Region and any area municipalities included on the Permit as additionally insured thereunder. Such insurance shall be extended to include the following endorsements: Blanket Contractual Liability and Cross Liability with a Severability of Interests Clause. Such insurance shall state that coverage will not be suspended, voided, cancelled, reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days prior written notice by certified mail to the Region. The applicant shall purchase and maintain automobile third party liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000 acceptable to the Region throughout the term of the Agreement covering all owned, leased and non-owned automobiles used in connection with the activities governed by this Permit. This insurance coverage shall be primary insurance to the insurance carried by the Region or any area municipalities mentioned herein. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the Region or any area municipalities mentioned herein shall be excess of this insurance and shall not contribute with it.

Additional Superload Permit Conditions

- a. Specific vehicle configuration documentation is required
- b. Specific route is required
- c. Additional supporting information may be required

Post Oversize Load Approved Conditions

- 1) The applicant must contact Waterloo Regional Police Services and obtain escort (if required) for the Permit to be valid (519-650-8516);
- 2) For a Class 3 or 4 Permit the applicant (excluding fire department vehicle or road services vehicle applicants) is prohibited on Regional roads between the hours of 07:00 – 09:00 and 15:00 – 18:00.
