

Medical Exceptions to Extended Interval Form

Clients eligible for a Ministry approved medical exception to the extended dose interval must have either:

- this form completed by their treating specialist or primary care physician indicating they have one of the medical exceptions listed below **or**
- written documentation from their treating specialist or primary care physician confirming that they have one of the medical exceptions listed below.

This documentation must be brought to each vaccination appointment.

Clients who are eligible for an exception to the extended interval who do not present with a form will have their second dose appointment booked at 112 days. Once a form is completed, clients or their physician may change their second dose booking by emailing phecovidimms@regionofwaterloo.ca. Efforts will be made to schedule the second dose as close as possible to the recommended interval. The completed form must be brought to the second dose appointment.

Vaccine for shorter intervals will not be administered without the completed form.
