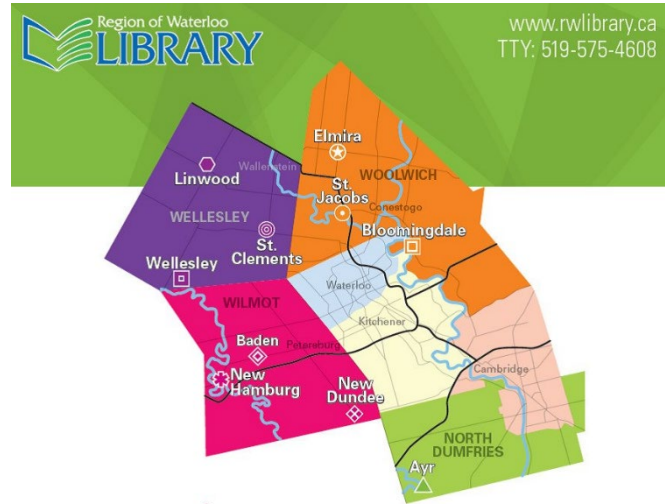
## Libraries
