

Kitchener Zone 4 Trunk Watermain

Project Information and Status Page

Study/Project Scope (What & Why)

The Region of Waterloo (Region) has identified the need for a new trunk watermain (Zone 4 Trunk WM) in Kitchener Pressure Zone 4 (KIT 4) to strengthen the distribution system and support growth in the south-west area of Kitchener. The trunk watermain will be installed between the Mannheim Zone 4 Pump Station on Ottawa Street to the future extension of Strasburg Road, approximately 7.0 km.

An Environmental Assessment and Preliminary Design was completed, in 2013, to determine the preferred alignment of a new 750mm trunk watermain to alleviate existing operational constraints and to strengthen the supply of water to the south end of Kitchener Pressure Zone 4.
