

Myers Road (Regional Road #43) Ramp to California Road

City of Cambridge

Study/Project Scope (What & Why):

This project is for the construction of a ramp connection from Myers Road to California Road in the City of Cambridge for pedestrians and cyclists. The project includes a new concrete ramp with retaining walls, handrails, lighting and replacing noise walls adjacent to the ramp.

Traffic calming improvements on Myers Road will be installed in a follow up Contract including:

- Adding raised pedestrian crossings just east of Lorraine Drive at the existing traffic signal, and in front of Moffat Creek School.
- Adding a pedestrian crossing at Gatehouse Road/Lisbon Pines Drive.

Preliminary Cost Estimate (Budget): \$2.2 million
