Dear Property Owners / Tenants,

The Region of Waterloo would like to inform you of an upcoming construction of the northbound shoulder widening of Trussler Road at Knetchel Court. The purpose of this letter is to provide property owners / tenants with more information about the scope of the work planned as part of the project

The limits of the project are contained to the intersection of Trussler Road and Knetchel Court. . The scope of the work generally includes removal of existing asphalt edge of pavement c/w saw-cutting and step joint, removal and disposal of a portion of existing shoulder granular "A" along the east side (northbound lane) of Trussler Road, road construction with the placement of granular "A" , HL8 and HL3 to specified width and thickness for shoulder widening. Application of pavement edge line, Blvd restoration with topsoil and seed.

The planning of this work is underway with the Region's contractor, Steed and Evans and will be completed in the coming weeks with construction operations scheduled to commence on or about August 2023. The overall duration of this work is expected to take 2 weeks to complete in its entirety with the road open for public use in summer of 2023. The project will be constructed in an effort to minimize inconvenience and maintain local access during construction. Due to the nature of the work, the roadway is anticipated to remain open to traffic on Trussler Road and Knetchel Court while construction work is being completed. Short-term travel lane closures and traffic control with flag-persons are planned in the summer of 2023.

We recognize that this project may be an inconvenience to local users and we will endeavor to minimize disruption / complete the work in a reasonable timeframe.

Staff from the Region of Waterloo are responsible for contract administration and staff from Walterfedy are providing inspection services for these works. 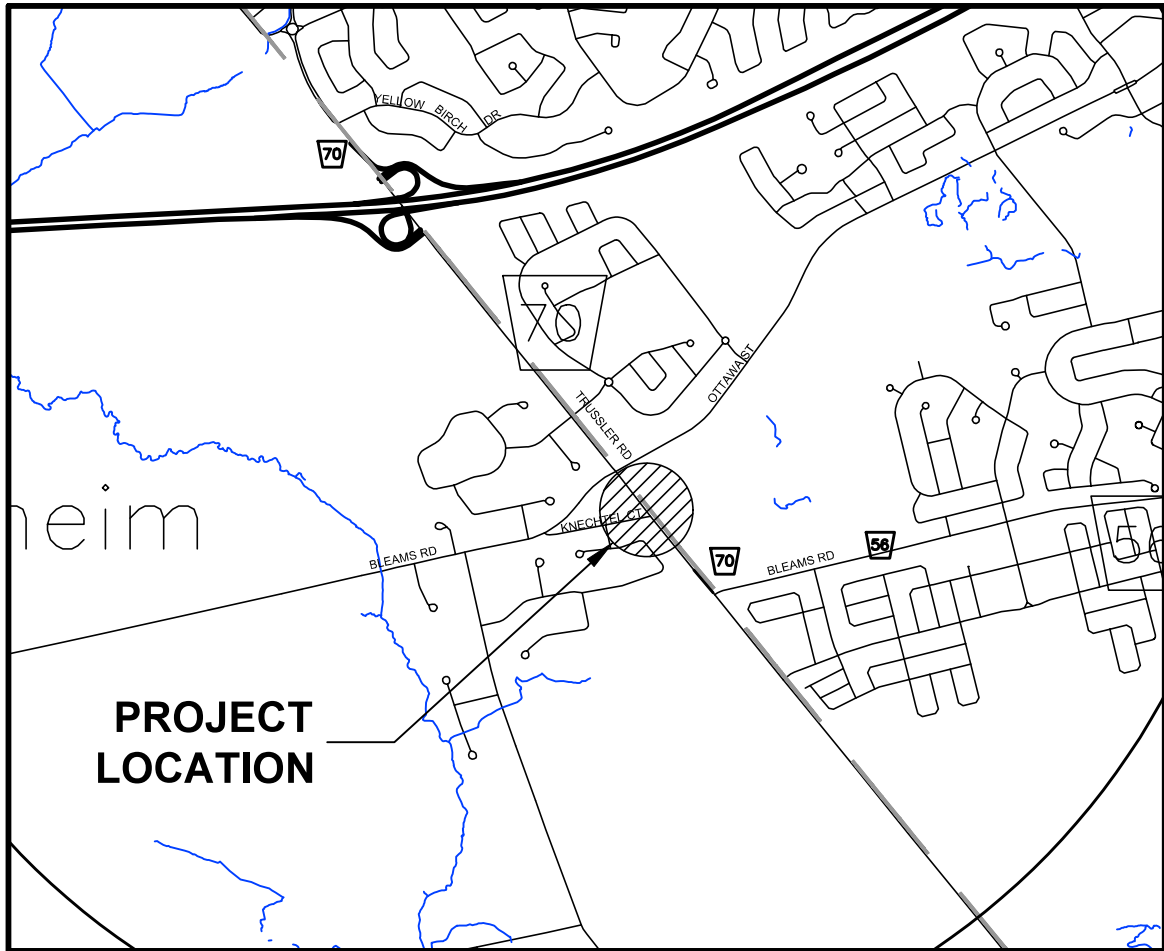
