Dear Property Owner, Tenant or Occupant.

Re: Regional Road No. 6 (Gingerich Road) from Regional Road No. 51 (Foundry Street) to Sandhills Road - Transmission Watermain, Intersection Signalization with Turning Lanes and Other Roadway Improvements, Township of Wilmot

The Region of Waterloo is preparing to commence construction on Gingerich Road from 60 metres west of Foundry Street to Sandhills Road. The anticipated start date of construction is **Monday, June 17, 2019**.

The work of this contract includes trench excavation, installation of transmission watermain, ditch reconstruction, municipal drain rehabilitation, removal of livestock concrete box crossings, turning lanes and traffic signals at the intersection of Gingerich Road and Foundry Street, asphalt multi use path and roadway rehabilitation.

General Information about this Project

Working Hours

Normal working hours are Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. On rare occasions, weekend or after-hours work may be necessary to minimize service disruptions.

Staging of Construction

The Region's Contract requirements for staging stipulate that Gingerich Road will be fully closed to all traffic/ through traffic. The Contractor will be required to maintain safe access at all times for local traffic. I have attached for your information, a diagram of the location of the posted detour route.

Contract Schedule

Construction is tentatively scheduled to commence on **June 17, 2019 with completion expected approximately October 31, 2019**.

Driveways and Restoration

The contractor may need to encroach onto private property at times during construction in order to restore or tie-in private driveways or boulevards. Driveways and boulevard areas disturbed by the construction will be fully restored to pre-construction conditions or better by the contractor. In order to

ensure that access to all local properties is maintained during construction, driveways will be constructed half at a time if sufficient width is available. If a property has two accesses, work will be limited to one driveway at a time. In locations with only one narrow driveway to the property, it will be necessary to close the driveway for short durations during certain construction activities. In these instances, property owners will be contacted well in advance of any planned driveway closure by the Contractor.



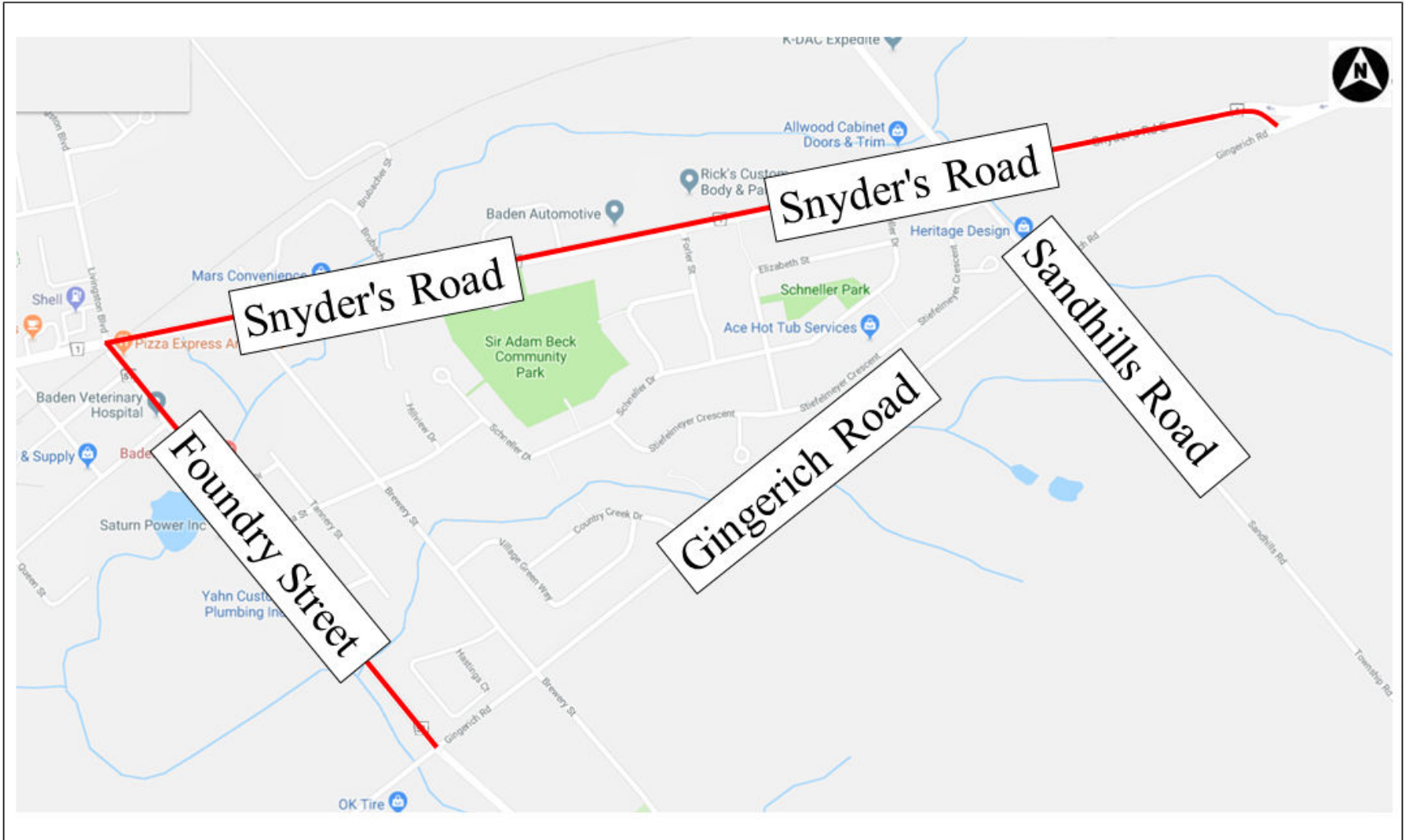
