

Northumberland Street Improvements Canadian Pacific Railway (CPR) tracks to Nith River Way and 130m to 150m North of Guthrie Street

Study/Project Scope (What & Why):

Improvements to Northumberland Street from the CPR tracks to Nith River Way are planned for construction in the summer of 2021 including, widening on both sides of the roadway to accommodate 3 new northbound left-turn lanes, full-depth asphalt removal and replacement, installation of new drainage structures and leads, extension of existing storm leads, minor repairs to underground services and installation of service stubs for future use, limited sidewalk replacement, and watermain interconnection work at approximately 130m to 150m north of Guthrie Street.
