Dear Property Owners / Tenants,

The Region of Waterloo would like to inform you of an upcoming construction of active transportation improvements including improved pedestrian and cycling measures and connections on Weber Street from Victoria Street to Wilhelm Street. The purpose of this letter is to provide property owners / tenants with more information about the scope of work planned as part of the project.

The limits of the project are Weber Street from Victoria Street to Wilhelm Street. The scope of the work generally includes removal and replacement of concrete sidewalk and curb and gutter complete with truncated dome detectable warning plates and directional grooves. 1 Traffic signal pole to be relocated at the s/w quadrant of the intersection of Victoria St and Weber St. 1 traffic signal poles to be relocated at the s/w quadrant of the intersection of Wellington St and Weber St. 1 traffic signal pole to be relocated in the n/w quadrant of the intersection of Wellington St and Weber St. Removal and disposal of 2(n/w and s/w quadrants) temporary poles at intersection of Wellington St and weber St. Milling and resurfacing of asphalt to repair low spot at the s/w quadrant of the intersection of Wilhelm St and Weber St. Removal of existing pavement markings, placement of thermoplastic pavement markings. Boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.

The planning of this work is underway with the Region's contractor, Steed and Evans and will be completed in the coming weeks with construction operations scheduled to commence on or about September 2023. The overall duration of this work is expected to take 1 weeks to complete in its entirety with the road open for public use in fall of 2023. The project will be constructed in an effort to minimize inconvenience and maintain local access during construction. Due to the nature of the work, the roadway is anticipated to remain open to traffic on Weber Street and associated side streets while construction work is being completed. Short-term travel lane closures and traffic control with paid duty officer are planned in the fall of 2023.

We recognize that this project may be an inconvenience to local users and we will endeavor to minimize disruption / complete the work in a reasonable timeframe.

Staff from the Region of Waterloo are responsible for contract administration and staff from Walterfedy are providing inspection services for these works. 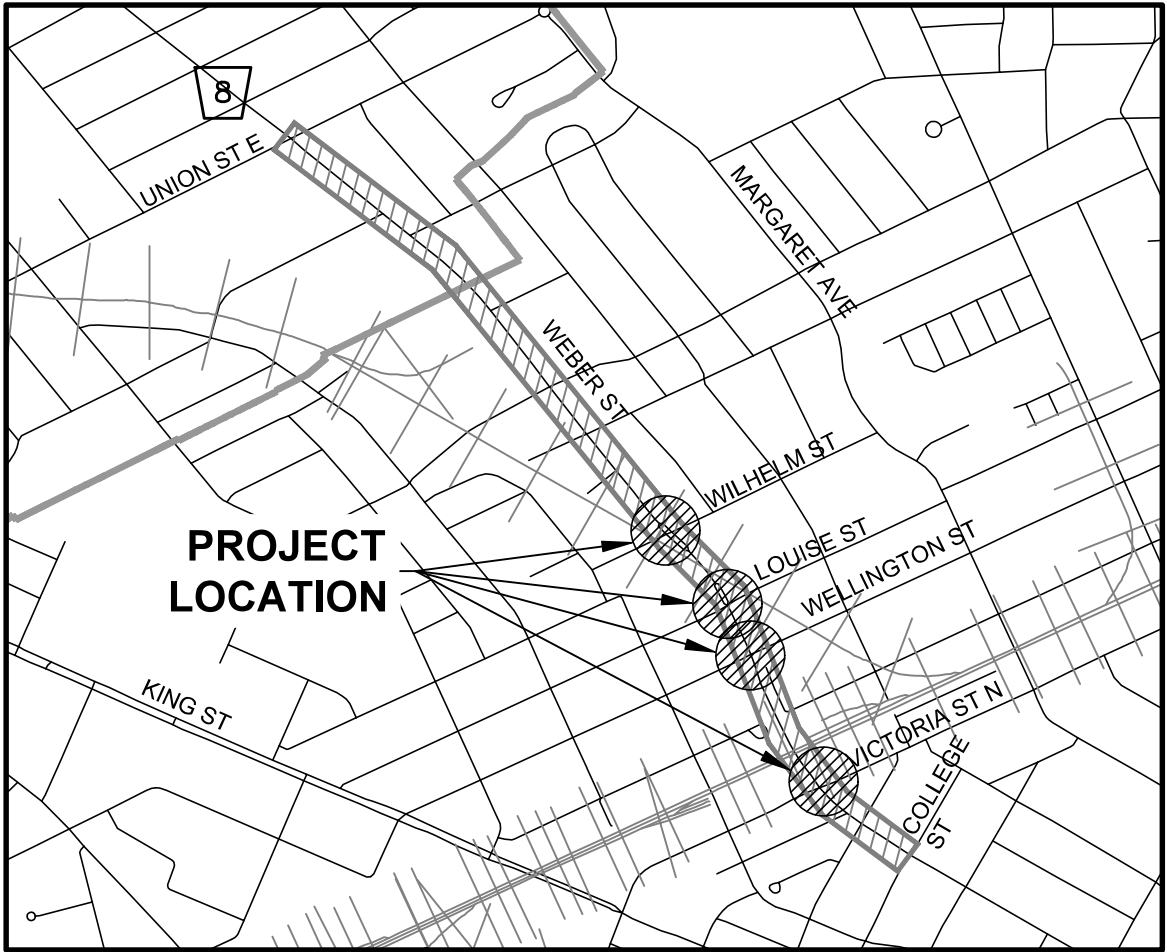
