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Dear Property Owners / Tenants and to Whom It May Concern,

The Region of Waterloo would like to inform you of an upcoming construction of a Multi-Use Path complete with lighting through Kingsdale Park. The purpose of this letter is to provide property owners / tenants with more information about the scope of work planned as part of the project

The limits of the project are contained to Kingsdale Park, between Connaught Street and Cedarwoods Crescent. The scope of the work generally includes removal of existing concrete sidewalk, construction of a 3.0m wide asphalt multi-use path including entrance bollards. Path lighting with independent lighting pole bases, poles, arms and fixtures, path markings and site restoration with topsoil, sod and seed.

The planning of this work is underway with the Region's contractor, Steed and Evans and will be completed in the coming weeks with construction operations scheduled to commence on or about August 2023. The overall duration of this work is expected to take 2 months to complete in its entirety with the Multi-Use Path open for public use in summer/fall of 2023. The project will be constructed in an effort to minimize inconvenience and maintain local access during construction. Due to the nature of the work, the path is anticipated to remain closed while the bulk of construction work is completed, with appropriate safety measures in place.

We recognize that this project may be an inconvenience to local users and we will endeavor to minimize disruption / complete the work in a reasonable timeframe.

Staff from the Region of Waterloo are responsible for contract administration and staff from Walterfedy are providing inspection services for these works. 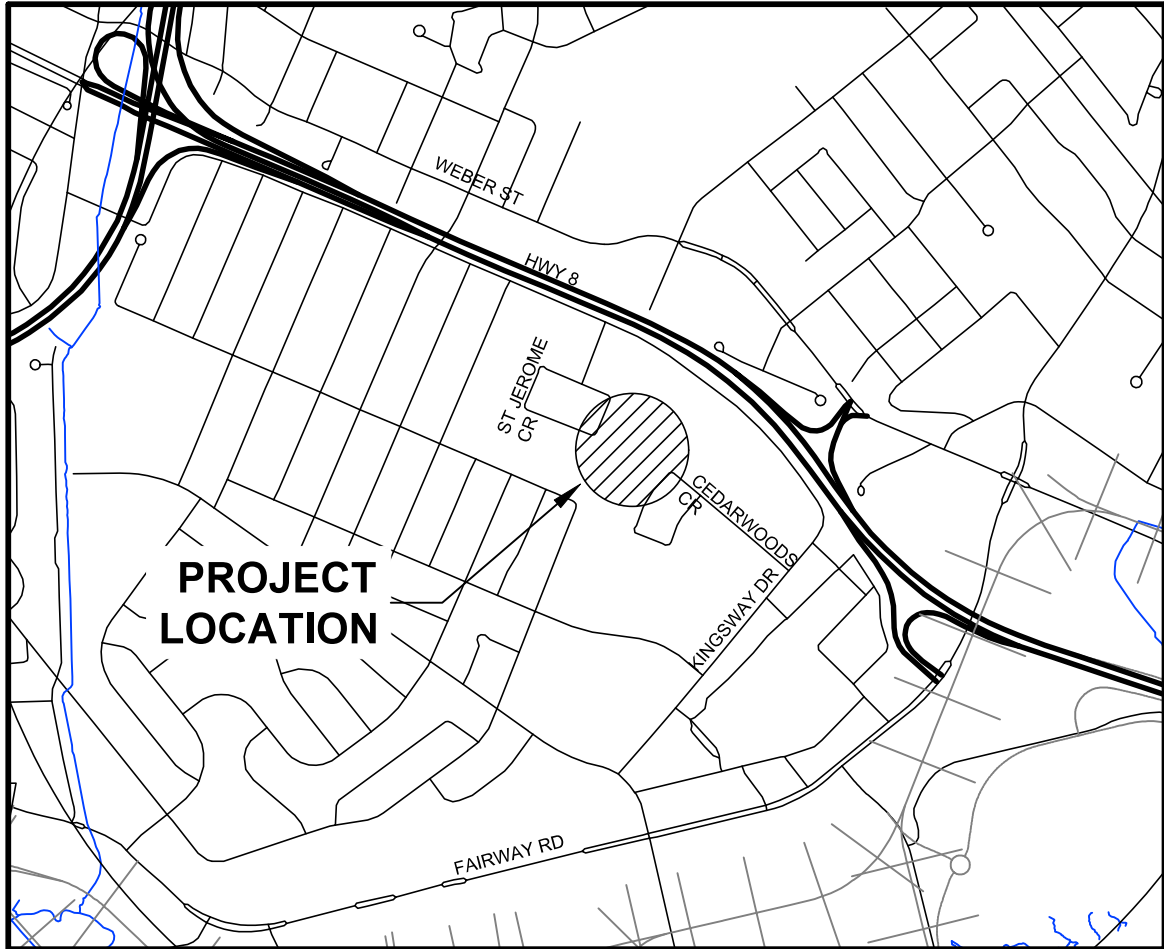
