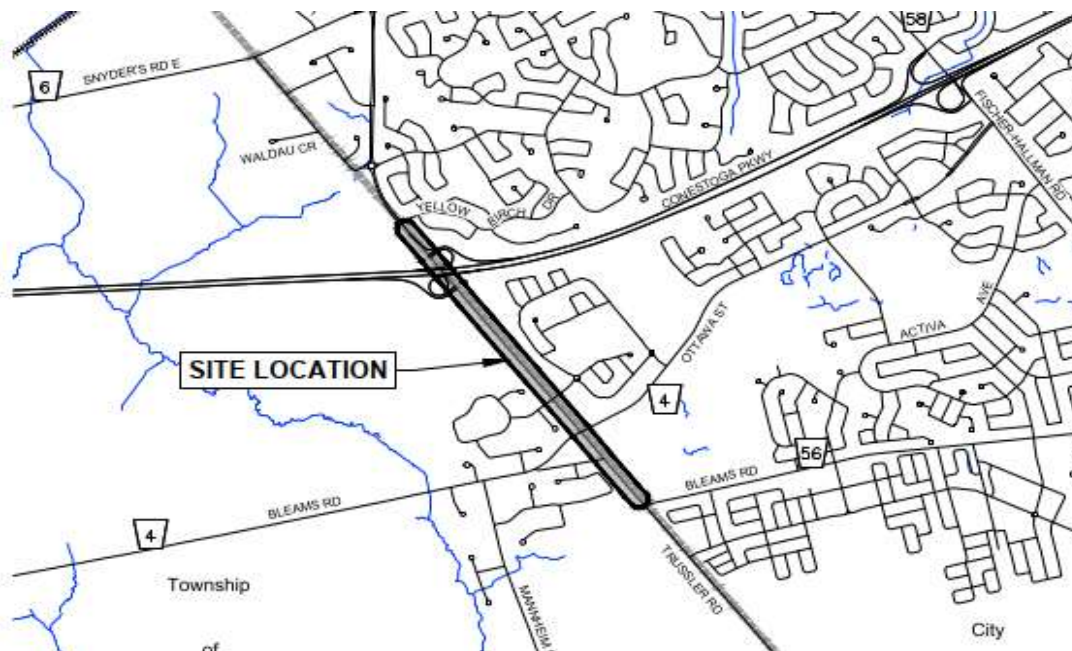


# Public engagement: Trussler Road improvements City of Kitchener and Township of Wilmot November 12–December 12, 2024
