Westmount Road Reconstruction Fischer-Hallman Road to Block Line Road, Kitchener

Project overview

The Region of Waterloo is planning improvements to Westmount Road between Fischer-Hallman Road and Block Line Road in Kitchener. The project will include pavement rehabilitation, installation of new storm sewers, improved active transportation facilities for pedestrians and cyclists, new GRT bus stops, permanent traffic signals at Westmount Rd. and Tilsley Dr., and intersection improvements at Westmount Road/Fischer-Hallman Road and Westmount Road/Block Line Road.

These improvements will make it easier and safer for all residents to get around, whether by car, public transit, bike, or foot.

Current stage: Detailed Design

Estimated construction start: 2026

Project Budget (2024 TCP Council approved): \$3,210,000

Project details

The project will include the installation of a new storm sewer system including curb and gutter and reconstruction of the road base and asphalt. The road will continue to have two lanes of traffic, one in each direction, and will retain all existing turning lanes. A new grass median will separate the two directions of traffic.

New wider sidewalks and single direction cycle tracks will be added in the boulevard on both sides of the road. GRT improvements will include the addition of two new bus stops on both sides of Westmount Rd. at Tilsley Dr. as well as upgrades to existing bus pads to address increased ridership.

Permanent traffic signals will be installed at Westmount Rd. and Tilsley Dr. to replace the temporary signals installed in 2023. Improvements to the intersection of Fischer-Hallman Rd. and Block Line Rd. will also be included in the project works.
