Regional Road 56 (Bleams Road) From Just West of Fischer-Hallman Road to Trussler Road, Kitchener

Class Environmental Assessment Study, Schedule C Project

Project Scope

The 2021 Regional Transportation Master Plan (RTMP) has identified this section of Bleams Road for reconstruction, installation of streetlighting and multi use trails.

As such, the Region of Waterloo is undertaking a Schedule C Class Environmental Assessment Study (EA), preliminary design, detailed design and construction.

The study will investigate current and projected traffic patterns between Fischer-Hallman Road and Trussler Road to determine the need for improvements to accommodate the intensification of land along Bleams Road. Pedestrians, cyclists and motorists will be considered throughout the study to ensure efficient and desirable interconnections between developments on both sides of the roadway. The results of this study will determine which intersection improvements are required and can be incorporated into the design and subsequent construction.
