

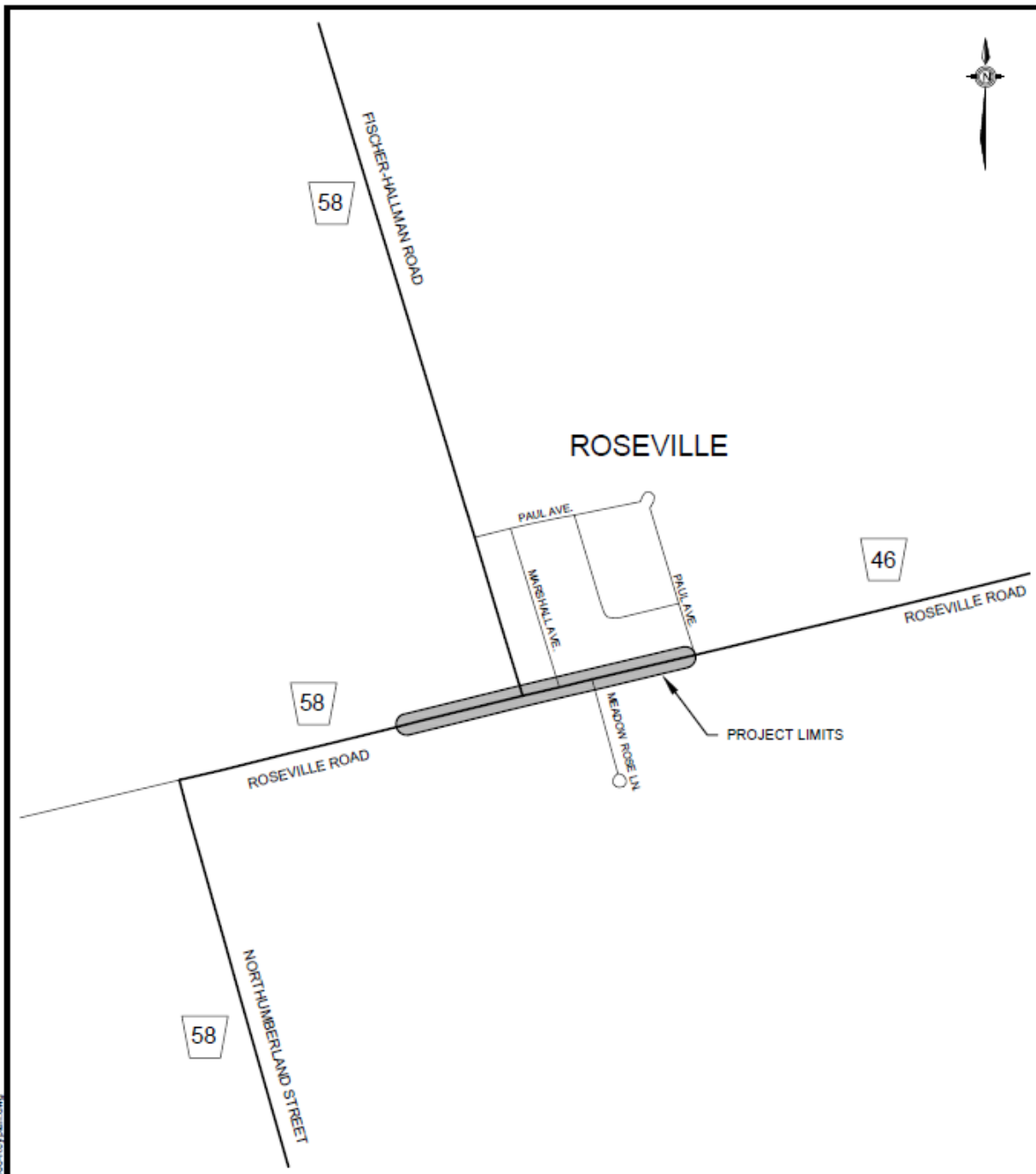

## **Background**

The Region of Waterloo is undertaking a Schedule 'A+' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for reconstruction of Roseville Road (Regional Road 46) corridor from 0.6km west of Fischer-Hallman Road to 0.4km east of Fischer-Hallman Road in the village of Roseville. Reconstruction of Roseville Road is being completed to provide road improvements for traffic growth and active transportation improvements for pedestrians and cyclists along the corridor.

The proposed project scope includes major asphalt resurfacing, a storm sewer spot repair, installation of new sidewalks, maintaining existing on-road cycling lanes, a pedestrian refuge island east of Fischer-Hallman Road at the Roseville Community Center, addition of in-fills of street lighting on existing utility poles to improve illumination, and installation of a waterproofing membrane on the existing concrete box culvert at 3250 Roseville Road. Construction of this project is tentatively scheduled for the spring to fall period of 2022.

## **The Process**

The project is being conducted in accordance with the requirements of a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act (Last Amended 2010).

This is a Public Consultation Centre and the Project Team will be presenting the needs and opportunities for improvements on Roseville Road to the public. This Public Consultation Centre is designed to provide interested members of the public, local businesses, community, and agencies the opportunity to meet the Project Team, get an update on the project work completed to date, and discuss project issues.
