Study/Project Scope (What & Why)

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo (Region) is undertaking a Schedule A+ Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for intersection and active transportation improvements on Homer Watson Boulevard. The project limits includes Homer Watson Boulevard from Conestoga College Boulevard to Manitou Drive in the City of Kitchener. Homer Watson Boulevard is a major north-south arterial road experiencing traffic issues and has insufficient pedestrian and cycling facilities. As a result, improvements are being recommended including intersection improvements, a new multi-use trail on the east side including separated pedestrian bridges over Schneider Creek and rehabilitation to the existing North Schneider Creek bridge.
