

# Water Street Improvements

## Myers Road – Ainslie Street, Cambridge

---

### Project overview

The Region of Waterloo is planning improvements to Water St S between Myers Rd and Ainslie St in Cambridge. The project will include pavement rehabilitation, and new transit, cycling and pedestrian facilities.

These improvements make it easier and safer for everyone to get around, whether by public transit, bike, foot or by car.

**Current stage:** Design

**Estimated construction start date:** 2025

**Project budget:** \$2,800,000

### Project details

The project will include milling of the existing asphalt surface and repaving.

We will be removing the existing on-road cycle lanes and upgrading the current path to a multi-use path that is separated by concrete barriers. This multi-use path will run from Myers Road to Ainslie Street.

Pedestrian islands will be added to improve connection between the multi-use path and the Cambridge to Paris Rail Trail and Churchill Park.
