Study/Project Scope (What & Why):

Construction of a 3.0m wide multi-use trail adjacent to the Waterloo Central Railway line between Northfield Drive West and Farmer's Market Road, including drainage improvements, extension of the Forwell Creek culvert, connections to adjacent properties and street lighting. The project is divided into two stages. The section of trail adjacent to the railway tracks between Northfield Drive and Farmer's Market Road was complete in 2022. The section between the railway and the Northfield Drive/Parkside Drive intersection, behind the Fire Hall, is planned for construction in Fall 2024.

Preliminary Cost Estimate (Budget): \$2.5 million
