Collectable Material**

Collectable Material Class	Items:
Blue Box Material	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • aerosol spray cans (empty) • aluminum foil and foil trays • books (hard and soft covered) • boxboard (cereal, tissue, detergent-type, cardboard egg cartons, toilet tissue/paper towel rolls) • cardboard (unwaxed, clean) • drinking boxes • foil trays and foil wrap (clean) • juice cartons • milk cartons • glass bottles and jars that contained beverage, food, detergent, personal care or pet care products at the point of purchase • magazines and catalogues • metal food and beverage cans • paint cans (empty, dry, lids off and not exceeding 4 litres in volume) • newspapers • paper (writing, computer, envelopes) • plastic containers (rigid) that contained beverage, food, detergent, personal care or pet care at the point of purchase and that are #1 PET (Polyethylene Terephthalate), #2 HDPE (High Density Polyethylene), #3 PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride), #5 PP (Polypropylene) or #7 (Other Plastics) containers • plastic film that is #4 LDPE (Low Density Polyethylene), plastic wrap or any other plastic shopping bags • telephone directories • other materials as set out on www.regionofwaterloo/waste
Bulky Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bathtub • BBQ • bicycle • boxspring • carpet/underlay • counter top • cupboard • drywall • flooring • floor lamp • furniture • laundry tub (plastic) • mattress • rug or mat • sink

Collectable Material Class	Items:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • toilet (tank and bowl separated if possible) • vacuum cleaner • wood (without nails) • other materials as set out on www.regionofwaterloo/waste
Green Bin Material	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • paper liner bag • compostable plastic liner bag as certified by the Canadian or American Compost Councils • bones • butcher paper • coffee filters, grounds • corn cobs, husks • eggshells • facial tissues • feathers • flour and sugar bags • food • fur • gravy, sauces, cooking oil, grease, lards, fats, condiments (less than 1 cup) • hair • houseplants • nail clippings • nuts, shells • paper cups, plates, napkins, bags • paper towels, tissues • paper fast food wrap • pet waste wrapped in a fiber or compostable product • microwave popcorn bags • pumpkins • sawdust wrapped in a fiber or compostable product • shredded paper (handfuls only) • tea bags • wood ashes (cold and wrapped in a fibre or compostable product) • wood chips • other materials as set out on www.regionofwaterloo/waste
Large Metal Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • air conditioner (central or window unit) • bath tub • dehumidifier • dishwasher • dryer (clothes) • freezer (chest and upright) • fridge (refrigerator) • heat pump/exchanger • humidifier • lawn mower (with fluids removed)

Yard Waste Material	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • brush • corn stalks • grass • hedge and tree trimmings • leaves • pine needles and cones • plants • sod edgings • weeds • other materials as set out on www.regionofwaterloo/waste

Non-Collectable Material

Non-Collectable Material	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• material that does not meet the size, weight or other restrictions as prescribed for the Collectable Material Class in this Schedule• aerosol spray cans, paint cans and food containers that are not as empty as possible• ammunition• animals/fowl (alive or dead) or carcasses or part of an animal/fowl or other creature, save for normal and bona fide Green Bin Material• automotive parts or accessories• compressed gas cylinders, gasoline tanks, fire extinguishers or sealed drums• concrete, rocks, patio slabs/stone, bricks• drums or barrels (sealed)• electronics• gaseous, semi-liquid or liquid waste, including liquid industrial waste as defined in Ontario Regulation 347, R.R.O. 1990, under the Environmental Protection Act or any successor legislation• glass items (unbroken) greater than 1 metre x 1 metre or broken glass items not prepared to protect personal safety during collection• Green Bin Material or Yard Waste Material in plastic bags• hazardous waste which is corrosive, flammable, radioactive, toxic (including pesticides or herbicides), explosive, capable of starting fires or biomedical or pathological or as defined in Ontario Regulation 347, R.R.O. 1990, under the Environmental Protection Act or any successor legislation• lumber, branches or stumps thicker than 8 centimeters by 8 centimeters• manufacturing or industrial waste• manure or waste from any animal, save and except for waste from household pets• prohibited material as defined under the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act 1992 (S.C. 1992, c. 34) or any successor legislation• sharp object(s) of any kind that may pose a safety hazard to Regional staff or the Region's waste collection contractor (such as medical or veterinary equipment intended for the purpose of cutting or piercing and includes medical needles or syringes)• sludge (such as septic tank contents, raw sewage sludge, industrial process sludge)• stock of any wholesaler or retailer• other materials as set out on www.regionofwaterloo/waste
