

Registration for the Rain Barrel Giveaway Draw commences on October 1, 2020 and closes at 11:59 pm. (E.T.) on October 31, 2020.

**Entry:**

1. To enter,
  - a) Visit [www.regionofwaterloo.ca/conservation](http://www.regionofwaterloo.ca/conservation)
    - i. Select “Reducing Water Use at Home”, followed by “Water Softeners”
    - ii. Under the “Step 1” heading, click “Register online”
  - b) Provide the information requested by the form.  
Entrant will be provided the option to have a water hardness testing kit mailed to them or to schedule a WET Program Home Audit with Reep Green Solutions
  - c) Entrant to follow instructions provided by Reep Green Solutions or in the mailed water hardness testing kit
  - d) Final water hardness results can be submitted online at [www.regionofwaterloo.ca/conservation](http://www.regionofwaterloo.ca/conservation):
    - i. Select “Reducing Water Use at Home”, followed by “Water Softeners”
    - ii. Under the “Step 2” heading, click “submit online”
  - e) Provide the information and upload water hardness results as requested on the form
  - f) Select “Enter me in the draw for a rain barrel” to be automatically entered into the draw
2. The Contest commences on October 1, 2020 and closes at 11:59 pm. (E.T.) on October 31, 2020.
3. No purchase, expenditure or investment is necessary to enter this Contest.
4. Maximum of 1 Contest Entry per household. If more than one entry is received from a household, all such entries will be disqualified from the random draw.
5. Residents who participated in rain barrel draws earlier in 2020 cannot reapply for the current draw.
6. The Region of Waterloo’s Water Efficiency Department administrators and their immediate families are not eligible for the draw prizes.

**Eligibility:**

7. Entrants must be a resident of the Region of Waterloo. Entrants must have submitted water hardness test results for a home they own (not an apartment or business) between October 1<sup>st</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> 2020 using one of the following methods:

**Prize Information:**

There will be 25 rain barrels available to be won by eligible respondents. The rain barrel will come with a lid and connection kit.

The rain barrel must be accepted as awarded and is non-refundable, non-transferable and non-redeemable for any cash value. The Region is not responsible for replacing the rain barrel if it is lost, stolen, destroyed or used without your knowledge or consent.

**Winner Selection:**

8. The random draw for the prize will be conducted by one or more Water Efficiency Water Softener Plumbing Rebate program administrators.
9. The prize will be drawn from all completed submissions received during the Contest until the closing date set out in section 3 of these Rules and Regulations.
10. Each selected entrant will be notified by 4:00PM (ET) on November 6, 2020 using the contact information provided with their entry following the draw and again within 14 days of the draw.
11. The selected entrants must correctly answer a skill testing question posed by the Water Efficiency Water Softener Plumbing Rebate program administrator(s) before being declared the winner.
12. In the event that the selected entrant incorrectly answers the skill testing question pursuant to item 14 above, or cannot be contacted pursuant to item 13 above, another entrant will be randomly selected for the applicable prize.
13. The Region's rulings on the winner are final and without appeal in all matters related to this Contest and the awarding of the prize.
14. Selected entrants must provide confirmation of a delivery address and any other information required to ensure delivery of their prize. The rain barrel will then be delivered by Region of Waterloo staff to the address provided.
15. In the event the selected entrant does not comply with these contest rules and regulations, or cannot be contacted within 30 days of the draw, or declines the prize, an alternate entrant will be selected from the remaining entries.
16. Chances of winning are dependent upon the total of eligible entries received. The Region is unaware of how many entries there may be.
