Water saving tips

Encourage water-efficient behaviours. Ideas available at regionofwaterloo.ca/conservation



Replace older toilets and check toilet flappers for leaks

Install high efficiency shower heads and aerators



Look for WaterSense and Energy Star logos to help choose efficient fixtures

Check regularly for leaks

Toilet flapper replacement

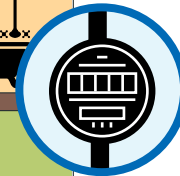
Receive a \$15 rebate for every toilet flapper you replace. Receive free showerheads and aerators from the Region of Waterloo when you register for program.



Fixture replacement
Receive funding assistance to upgrade toilets and other fixtures. Funding is based on your investment and water savings achieved.

Cost sharing for water audits and consulting fees

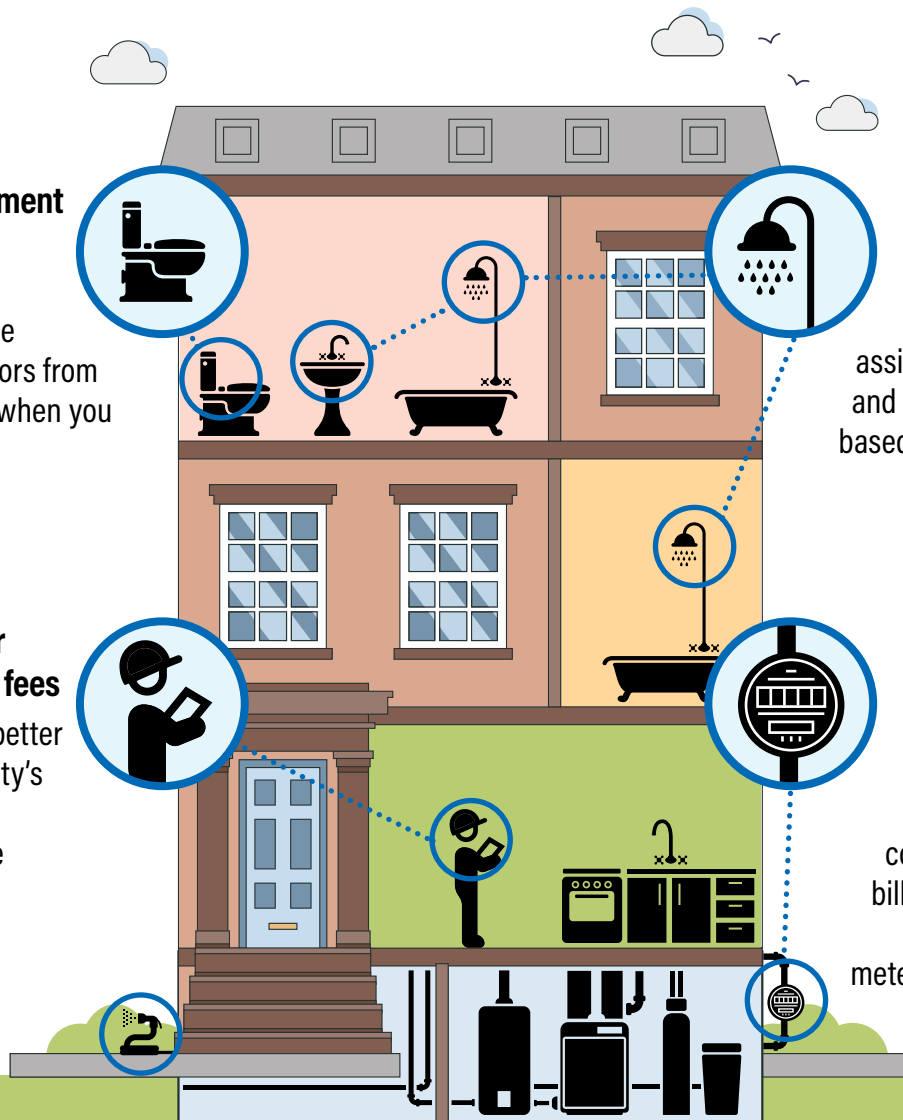
A water audit can help better understand your property's water consumption and highlight issues. Eligible projects can apply for 50% funding up to a maximum of \$10,000.



Cost sharing for sub-metering projects
Sub-metering data can help find problems and encourage water conservation measures by billing tenants for the water they actually use. Sub-metering projects are eligible for 50% funding up to a maximum of \$10,000.
