

A YIELD COLLISION

You can avoid!

Yield to motorists in **all** lanes of the roundabout because they have the right-of-way.

This motorist (in the red car) is at fault. This motorist must yield to motorists in **all** lanes in the roundabout, not just motorists in the outside lanes.

Lane signs and road markings indicate motorists can exit from either lane.

YIELDING Tips

YIELDING to Motorists

- Slow down as you approach a roundabout.
- Yield to motorists in **all** lanes of the roundabout because motorists already in the roundabout can exit from any lane.
- You may have to come to a full stop before entering the roundabout if there is no suitable gap available due to motorists already in the roundabout.



YIELDING to Pedestrians

- Expect pedestrians when entering and exiting a roundabout, and yield to them at all crosswalks.
- You may have to come to a full stop at a crosswalk for pedestrians when they are crossing.
