


Notice of Public Consultation Centre No. 2



Stage 2 ION: LRT from Kitchener to Cambridge

In June 2011, Region of Waterloo Council approved a staged approach to light rail transit (LRT). Stage 1 ION (currently under construction) includes LRT from Kitchener to Waterloo and bus rapid transit (BRT) between Cambridge and Kitchener (launched in September 2015). Stage 2 ION will see BRT replaced by LRT. The first Public Consultation Centres introduced various route options under consideration along with the criteria to be used during the evaluation process. At the next Public Consultation Centre, the evaluation process and results, along with the preliminary preferred route will be presented to the public for input.
