A By-law to Amend By-laws 20-034 and 20-051 That Had Amended By-law 13-050, A By-Law Respecting the Conduct of Persons Entering Upon Buildings, Grounds and Public Transportation Vehicles Owned or Occupied by The Regional Municipality of Waterloo

Whereas Council of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 13-050, A By-Law Respecting the Conduct of Persons Entering Upon Buildings, Grounds and Public Transportation Vehicles Owned or Occupied by The Regional Municipality of Waterloo (the “Code of Use By-law”);

And Whereas Council of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 20-034, A By-law to Amend the Code of Use By-law to require the wearing of face coverings in enclosed public places of Regional buildings and on public transit (the “By-law 20-034”);

And Whereas Council of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 20-051, A By-law to Amend By-law 20-034 and to further amend By-law 13-050, A By-Law Respecting the Conduct of Persons Entering Upon Buildings, Grounds and Public Transportation Vehicles Owned or Occupied by The Regional Municipality of Waterloo (the “By-law 20-051”);

And Whereas the Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo wishes to extend the requirement for persons to wear a face covering while within Regional public transportation vehicles, bus shelters and platforms at transit stations and in enclosed public places of Regional buildings to assist in reducing the spread of COVID-19 within The Regional Municipality of Waterloo;

The Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacts as follows:

1. By-law 20-034 is hereby amended by deleting section 6 and replacing it with the following:

“6. This By-law shall be reviewed by Council once the face covering requirements for businesses and organizations in the regulations of the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020, S.O. 2020, c. 17, are revoked.”

2. By-law 20-051 is hereby amended by deleting section 4 and replacing it with the following:

“4. Section 2 of this By-law shall be reviewed by Council once the face covering requirements for businesses and organizations in the regulations of the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020, S.O. 2020, c. 17, are revoked.”

3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on May 19, 2021.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed in the Council Chamber in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo this 19th day of May, A.D., 2021.
