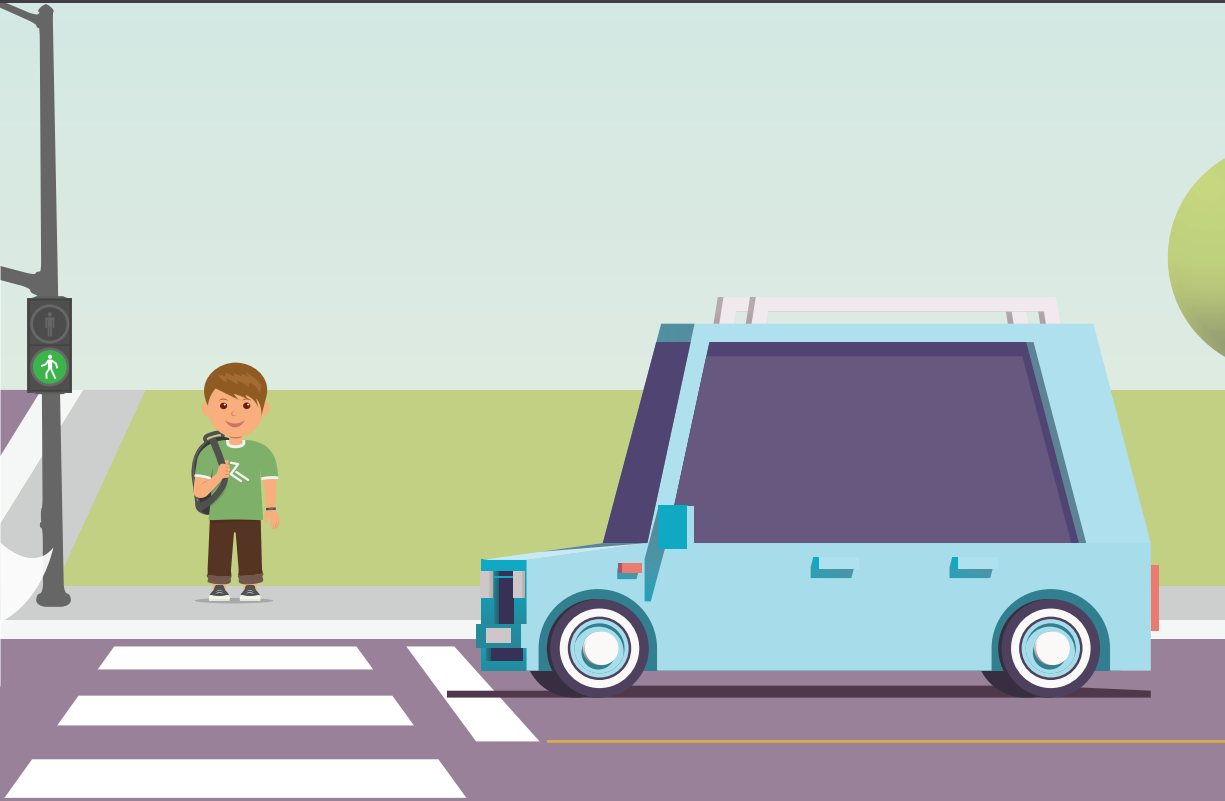


# CROSS WITH CARE at intersections



Pedestrians are at a higher risk when crossing the road - even at intersections with traffic signals.

Many of us use Waterloo Region roads as both drivers and pedestrians. Learn the role we all play in keeping pedestrians safe.



Before you walk across an intersection, **DO THE EXTRA SEC CHECK:**

Take a second to check traffic signals

Look left, right and ahead of you for turning vehicles

Continue to watch for vehicles as you cross

**One injury or fatality is one too many**



## CROSSWALKS

are the most common place for pedestrians to be struck

**89%**

of pedestrian collisions are at **signalized intersections**

**56%**

of pedestrian collisions occur when the pedestrian has the **right of way**

## Mind the crosswalk on your drive



**Pedestrians always have the right of way** at crosswalks



You should **expect crossing pedestrians** at every intersection



**Do the Extra Sec Check** and keep our walking friends, neighbours and kids safe

**1 in 3** pedestrian collisions are caused by a **turning vehicle**
