Definition:

Limitations:

These population estimates are produced by single year of age (up to 90+) and sex for Ontario's Census Subdivisions as of July 1 for each year. They are produced by the Demography Division of Statistics Canada, and are based on census counts adjusted for net under-coverage.

Students attending school out of town but who return home when school is not in session are included on their parents' questionnaire, as part of the regular household. As a result, the student population in Waterloo Region may be under-represented.
