

By-Law Number 18-023

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo

A By-law to Amend By-law 16-023, as Amended, Being a By-law to Regulate Traffic and Parking on Highways Under the Jurisdiction of the Regional Municipality of Waterloo

The Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacts as follows:

1. That Part VII, section 1, of the Traffic and Parking By-law 16-023 be deleted and replaced with the following:

“No person shall make or convey an offer of services of a tow truck while that person is within 200 metres of,

- a) the scene of an accident or apparent accident; or
- b) a vehicle involved in an accident,
on a highway.”

2. That Part VII, section 2, of the Traffic and Parking By-law 16-023 be deleted and replaced with the following:

“No person shall station or position a tow truck on a highway within 200 metres of,


- a) the scene of an accident or apparent accident; or
- b) a vehicle involved in an accident.”

3. This By-law shall take effect on the 10th day of May, 2018.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed in the Council Chamber in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo this 9th day of May, A.D., 2018.
