The Regional Municipality of Waterloo

A By-law to Repeal Provisions of By-law 13-050, A By-Law Respecting the Conduct of Persons Entering Upon Buildings, Grounds and Public Transportation Vehicles Owned or Occupied by The Regional Municipality of Waterloo, to Require the Wearing of Face Coverings in Enclosed Public Places of Regional Buildings, Enclosed Common Areas of Multi-Residential Buildings of the Region and Public Transit of the Region

Whereas Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 13-050, A By-Law Respecting the Conduct of Persons Entering Upon Buildings, Grounds and Public Transportation Vehicles Owned or Occupied by The Regional Municipality of Waterloo (the "Code of Use By-law");

And Whereas Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 20-034, A By-law to Amend the Code of Use By-law to require the wearing of face coverings in enclosed public places of Regional buildings and on public transit ("By-law 20-034");

And Whereas Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 20-051, A By-law to Amend By-law 20-034 and to further amend the Code of Use By-law ("By-law 20-051");


And Whereas Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacted By-law 21-026, A By-law to Amend By-law 20-034 and By-law 20-051;

And Whereas the Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo wishes to end the requirement for persons to wear a face covering while within Regional public transportation vehicles, bus shelters and platforms at transit stations; in enclosed public places of Regional buildings that are open to the public; and in enclosed common areas of multi-residential buildings or complexes that are operated by Housing Services of the Region, to assist in reducing the spread of COVID-19 within The Regional Municipality of Waterloo;


The Council of The Regional Municipality of Waterloo enacts as follows:

1. Subsections 2(2.2) and 2(2.3) of Schedule "B" of the Code of Use By-law, as amended by By-laws 20-034 and 20-051, are hereby repealed effective on March 21, 2022.
2. Subsections 1(1.1) and 2(2.1) of Schedule "B" of the Code of Use By-law, as amended by By-laws 20-034 and 20-051, are hereby repealed upon the revocation of the requirement to wear a mask or face covering in public transit vehicles pursuant to the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*, S.O. 2020, c. 17, as amended, and its regulations.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally passed in the Council Chamber in the Regional Municipality of Waterloo this 16th day of March, A.D., 2022.
