**Re: Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA), Schedule C
Maple Grove Road Improvements
City of Cambridge**

Regional staff will take a report to the May 10 Planning and Works Committee meeting with recommended design alternatives for Maple Grove Road in Cambridge. Staff will also be looking for approval to file a Notice of Completion for this project's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

The recommended alternative considered technical information gathered for this study and all public comments received. The project team is recommending the following cross-section elements as the Recommended Design Alternative for the Maple Grove Road corridor between Hespeler Road and Vondrau Drive:

- a three metre-wide multi-use path along each side of the road;
- a five metre-wide raised centre median;
- four lanes of through traffic;
- curb and gutter;
- storm sewers; and
- street lighting.

Funding for the Maple Grove Road Improvements project is included in the Region's 10-Year Transportation Capital Program. The 2022 Transportation Capital Program includes detailed design and construction scheduled for 2022 and 2023 through 2025 respectively.

The Regional Planning and Works Committee meeting on May 10 is scheduled to start at approximately 9 a.m., and is streamed live at regionofwaterloo.ca
