Herrgott Road Boomer Creek Bridge

Township of Wellesley

June 2026 – November 2026

South of Ament Line

Notice date: June 11, 2026

About the project

The Region of Waterloo is rehabilitating the Herrgott Road Boomer Creek Bridge, located south of Ament Line in the Township of Wellesley. The work includes concrete deck overlay, railing removal and replacement, paving, deck drain replacement, and other bridge improvements. These upgrades will help extend the life of the bridge, improve traffic operations, and support existing and future transportation needs in the area.

Timing — starts on or about June 22, 2026

Construction is expected to begin on or about June 22, 2026, and be completed by November 2026, with asphalt paving planned during the 2026 construction season.

Closures (or lane reductions)

Two-way traffic will be maintained during construction, with Herrgott Road at Boomer Creek Bridge reduced to a single lane. Road users should expect some delays.

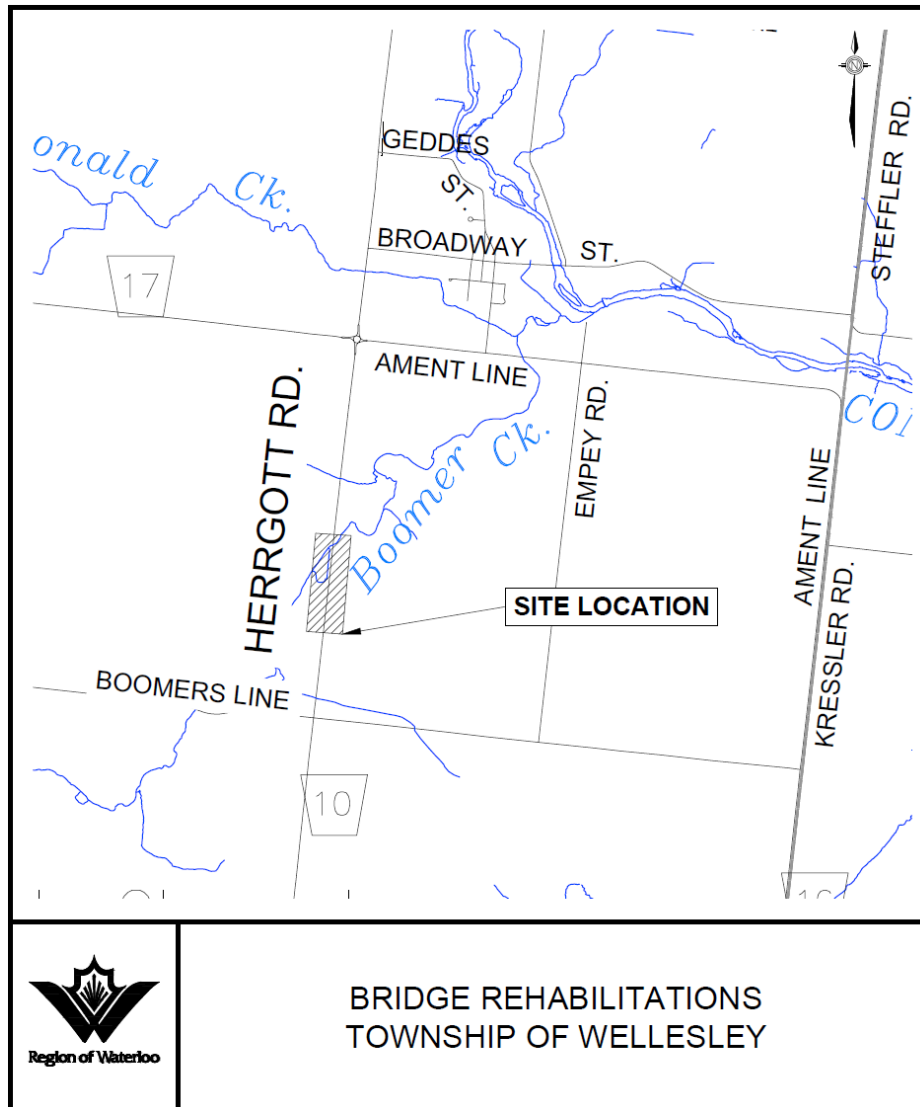
Property and business access
