



Construction Update: New Dundee Road Kitchener June 2026

Pinnacle Drive to Reichert Drive

Notice date: June 12, 2026

About the project

The Region of Waterloo has completed construction on New Dundee Road between Pinnacle Drive to Reichert Drive in Kitchener in 2025, which included a range of upgrades such as a new roundabout, road widening and installation of new underground sanitary sewer.

This year, work will continue to complete the remaining activities, which includes:

- Concrete sidewalk
- Curb and gutter
- Grass and landscaping restoration
- Final surface asphalt coat
- Final line painting and pavement markings

Timing

Preliminary work started on June 8, 2026, and will continue through the end of June 2026, with two-way traffic maintained.

Closures

New Dundee Road between Reichert Drive and Pinnacle Drive will be closed overnight on June 23 and 24 (7 p.m. to 6 a.m.). During these closures, there will be no access to New Dundee Road from Pinnacle Drive, Robert Ferrie Drive and Reichert Drive.

Outside of the overnight closures on June 23 and 24, New Dundee Road will remain open to two-way traffic throughout this work with some temporary lane restrictions at times. There may be periods when traffic will be controlled with flag persons.

Detour

During overnight closures (7 p.m. to 6 a.m.), local traffic should use the following routes to access Doon South:

- Eastbound: Stauffer Woods Trail

- Westbound: Conestoga College Drive and Pinnacle Drive

Emergency Services (Police, Fire, Paramedics) have been notified of the construction, closures and detours to minimize any disruptions to services.

Pedestrian access

The multi-use paths in this area will remain accessible during the project. Pedestrians should follow the signs as they walk through the site.

Property and business access

All businesses in the construction area remain open and accessible during construction. Every effort will be made to maintain access to residential and business driveways in the construction area during working hours (7 a.m.– 7 p.m.). Construction activities may temporarily impact access to entrances. We will provide advance notice of any interruption as soon as possible.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully within the construction zone. We request that when driving or walking through and around the construction zone you follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

Waste collection changes

Waste collection will not be impacted by the project.

Dust, mud and vibration

You may notice slight vibrations from the contractor's equipment during construction. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, mud and vibration.
