

Construction notice:

Cedar Creek Elevated Tank

About the project

The Region of Waterloo is constructing the Cedar Creek Elevated Tank and watermain along Cedar Creek Road, from 1233 Cedar Creek Road to the intersection of Grand Ridge Drive in Cambridge. This project will help maintain a reliable and resilient water system while supporting current and future growth in the area.

Timing- on or about September 8

Construction of the tank is anticipated to begin on or about September 8, 2026, and be completed by September 2028. Construction activity will take place between 7:00AM and 7:00PM Monday to Friday.

Construction impacts

Construction impacts for the Cedar Creek Elevated Tank project are expected to be limited.

Watermain construction is expected to take approximately 6 months. Advance notice about the anticipated start date will be shared with residents before the watermain construction begins.

During the watermain construction, work is expected to take place Monday to Friday, from 7:00AM to 7:00PM. There will be a temporary one-lane reduction on Cedar Creek Road, with traffic directed through the work area by flag staff. During periods when construction is inactive, including nights and weekends, all traffic lanes will be open.

Residents may notice occasional construction noise during daytime work hours.

Property and business access

All businesses in the construction area remain open and accessible during construction. Every effort will be made to maintain access to residential and business driveways in the construction area during working hours (7:00AM – 7:00PM). Construction activities may temporarily impact access to entrances. Notice of any interruption will be made in advance as much as possible.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully in the construction zone. When driving or walking through and around the construction zone please follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

Waste collection changes

Regular waste pickup will continue as scheduled during construction. The contractor will move the black and green carts, recycling bins, yard waste and bulky items as needed and will return empty containers to the correct property the same day. Please label your carts with your address and place all carts at your curb before 7:00AM on your regular collection day.

Restoration and landscaping

If your driveway or landscaping is damaged by construction, it will be replaced/reinstated to pre-construction condition. Sod that is replaced will be taken care of for 60 days. After 60 days, all sod maintenance and watering become the responsibility of the property owner.

Dust, mud and vibration

Slight vibrations from the contractor's equipment during construction may be noticed. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, mud, and vibration.
