

# Construction notice:

## New Dundee Road, Kitchener

### June–December 2025

## Fischer-Hallman Road to Homer Watson Boulevard

Notice date: June 17, 2025

### About the project

The Region of Waterloo is improving New Dundee Road in Kitchener. This year's work will be between Reichert Drive and Pinnacle Drive. This work includes:

- New roundabout at Robert Ferrie Drive and New Dundee Road
- New left turn lane for eastbound traffic to Pinnacle Drive from New Dundee Road
- Widening the road to add paved shoulders on the sides
- New multi-use path and pedestrian handrails on the north side of the road
- Installation of new underground sanitary sewer and watermain

### Timing — starts June 23, 2025

Construction will start on June 23, 2025 and extend through December 2025. The road will reopen over the winter 2025/2026.

Surface asphalt paving will occur over a few days in fall 2026.

### Closures

New Dundee Road between Fischer-Hallman Road and Homer Watson Boulevard will be closed to through traffic during this work. Only local access will be permitted through the construction zone.

### Detour

Eastbound traffic will be directed to take Fischer-Hallman Road and Huron Road to reach Homer Watson Boulevard.

Westbound traffic will be directed to take Homer Watson Boulevard to Bleams Road to Fischer-Hallman Road to reach New Dundee Road.

Local traffic can access the Doon South neighbourhood through Homer Watson Boulevard and Doon South Drive.

Emergency Services (Police, Fire, Paramedics) have been notified of the construction, closures and detours to minimize any disruptions to services.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully within the construction zone. We request that when driving or walking through and around the construction zone you follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

### **Property and business access**

All businesses in the construction area remain open and accessible during construction. Every effort will be made to maintain access to residential and business driveways in the construction area during working hours (7 a.m.–7 p.m.). Construction activities may temporarily impact access to entrances. We will provide notice of any interruption in advance as much as possible.

### **Pre-construction property assessment**

Businesses in the construction area will be contacted by a staff member from J-AAR Civil Infrastructures Ltd. to conduct a free pre-construction condition assessment. This will document the building's existing condition including any cracks and visible structural or cosmetic defects of the exterior and interior of the property.

If property owners/tenants suspect damage as a result of construction activities, the information for this assessment will help resolve the issue.

### **Restoration and landscaping**

If driveways or landscaping features are damaged by construction, we will replace/reinstate it to pre-construction condition. We will take care of any sod that is replaced for 60 days. After 60 days, all sod maintenance and watering become the responsibility of the property owner.

### **Dust, noise and vibration**

You may notice slight vibrations and noise from the contractor's equipment during construction. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, noise and vibration.
