## **Kitchener Central Transit Hub Public Art Competition**

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q:** I'm a Canadian Citizen, but others on my team are not. Can we still apply?

**A:** If the primary Team Lead is a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, and/or an Indigenous person residing in or originating from the unceded territories now known as Canada, you and your team are eligible to apply.

**Q:** Can I submit a proposal for an art installation at the initial Phase 1 stage?

**A:** No. Jurors will only review items listed in the Phase 1 requirements. We do not require a proposed art project at this time.

**Q:** When can I expect to know the outcome of the Phase 1 assessment process?

**A:** All applicants will be informed by email of their application status by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

**Q:** What is the anticipated overall project timeline for design, fabrication, and installation?

**A:** The timing for the selected artwork may be subject to change depending on revisions to the overall project schedules. It is important for the artist/artist team to have the flexibility to readily accommodate shifts in the timeline. At this point we estimate that the following timeframes may apply:

Art Design Development Complete: Fall 2027

Art Fabrication Complete: Spring 2029

Art Installation: Fall 2029 - Spring 2030

**Q:** What level of time commitment is expected from the selected artist or artist team for the duration of the project?

**A:** The selected artist/artist team will need to participate in meetings with the project design and construction team once the artist has information to share for co-ordinating the proposed aesthetics, artwork loads, dimensions, location(s), support requirements, delivery details, etc. The artist can propose the number of meetings and how often they should occur based on their needs.

We anticipate this will vary depending on how complicated the artwork is and on the extent of co-ordination needed. Given that this may change as the work progresses, it is important for the artists to have the flexibility to readily participate in co-ordination meetings as needed.
