

# Construction notice: Samuelson Street, Cambridge April–June, 2025

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## Eglin Street to Mill Creek Road

Notice date: March 28, 2025

### About the project

The Region of Waterloo, in consultation with the City of Cambridge, will install a new watermain along Samuelson Street. This work involves installing a new transmission/local watermain from Elgin Street N to Mill Creek Road, connecting to the new watermain installed last year.

Existing water services will be reconnected to the new watermain following installation by trenching. New service connections to properties are not required.

### Timing — starts April 14, 2025

Construction will be from April 14 to June 30, 2025.

### Closures

Between April 28 to May 2, northbound and southbound access to the Samuelson Street and Elgin Street intersection will be closed. Eastbound and westbound access will be maintained.

Two-way traffic will be maintained on Samuelson Street from Elgin Street N to Mill Creek Road prior to April 28 and after May 2. Traffic will be controlled by staff on site.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully through the construction zone following construction signs.

### Water supply interruptions

Water will need to be temporarily shut off at times to complete underground connections and to replace the local watermain. Residents will receive a paper notice of water shutdowns 48 hours in advance of any half or full day water interruptions. Residents will receive in-person notice the same day for 30–60-minute interruptions as needed.

### Pedestrian access

The sidewalks in this area will remain accessible during construction. Pedestrians should follow the signs as they walk through the site.

## **Pre-construction property assessment**

Residents and businesses in the construction area will be contacted through a paper notice from dBa Services Inc. to conduct a voluntary, free pre-construction condition assessment. This will document the building's existing condition, including any cracks and visible structural or cosmetic defects of the exterior and interior of the property.

If property owners/tenants suspect damage as a result of construction activities, the information for this assessment will help resolve the issue.

## **Waste collection changes**

Starting on April 14, 2025, please place your garbage in disposable bags (please avoid the use of containers) at the curb along with your blue box, green bin, and yard waste before 7 a.m. on your normal collection day. Where waste removal trucks do not have access, these materials will be collected by our contractor and placed in a communal pick-up location for Region pickup. Blue boxes and green bins will be returned by the day's end. It is important to ensure that your address number is clearly marked on your blue box and green bin to ensure proper return.

## **Restoration and landscaping**

If your driveway or landscaping is damaged by construction, we will replace/reinstate it to pre-construction condition. We will take care of any sod that is replaced for 60 days. After 60 days, all sod maintenance and watering become the responsibility of the property owner.

## **Dust, mud and vibration**

You may notice slight vibrations from the contractor's equipment during construction. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, mud and vibration.
