City of Waterloo
Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo has undertaken a planning study in accordance with the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act following the approved process for Schedule 'C' projects under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (October 2000, as amended through 2015) to address transportation system improvements in the City of Waterloo. The Recommended Design Alternative includes the following key elements:

- Widen the road from 2 to 4 lanes of through vehicle traffic; and, add new
- 3-metre-wide boulevard multi-use trail (MUT) along both sides of the road;
- Curb and gutter and a stormwater drainage system;
- 5.0-metre-wide raised curb, grassed median; and
- Additional street lighting.

By copy of this Notice, the Environmental Study Report is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and receipt of necessary approvals, the project may proceed to construction subject to Regional Council approval.

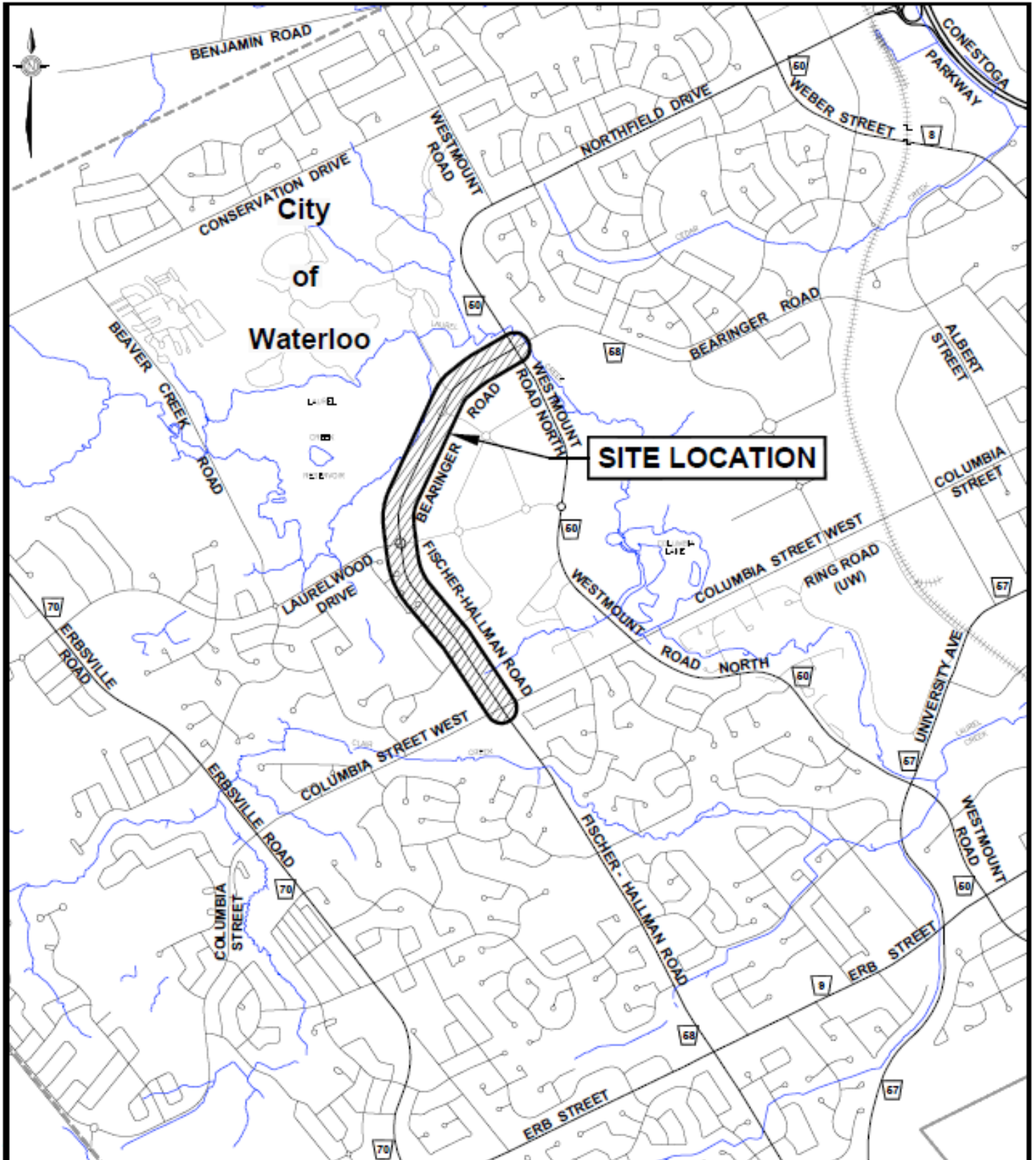
