East Boundary Road Corridor Study
City of Cambridge and Township of North Dumfries
Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo has undertaken a planning study in accordance with the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act following the approved process for Schedule 'C' projects under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (October 2000, as amended in 2015) to address a new transportation network facility in the City of Cambridge and Township of North Dumfries. The Recommended Design Alternative includes the following key elements:

- A western alignment through the City of Cambridge;
- A 40 metre wide right-of-way including 4 lanes of through traffic, multi-use trail along each side of the road, raised median (access control), street lighting, curb and gutter, and storm sewers;
- Roundabout intersection control at Wesley Boulevard, Main Street, Clyde Road, and Avenue Road/Gore Road;
- Bridge crossings for creek crossings of Moffat Creek and Mill Creek; and
- An above-grade crossing (overpass) at the CP Rail crossing.

By this Notice, the Environmental Study Report is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and receipt of necessary approvals, the project may proceed to construction subject to Regional Council approval.
