Supplementary Documentation: Detailed Site Location Information

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1.0 Detailed Site Location

According to Section 7.6 of the *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists* (S & G) administered by the Ministry of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries (MHSTCI), previously the Ministry of Tourism and Culture (MTC, 2011), any information that pinpoints the location of an archaeological site (e.g., detailed assessment results mapping, tables of Global Positioning System (GPS) coordinates for site locations) must not be included in the project report and should only be provided in the *Supplementary Documentation* document. This allows the MHSTCI to exclude it from the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports, if necessary. Archaeological site location information is considered by the MHSTCI to be confidential and/or sensitive information that cannot be made public.

Site descriptions and other relevant information relating to all archaeological work conducted for the project are contained in our accompanying Stage 2 assessment report for the Fischer-Hallman Road Improvements (ASI, 2022).

1.1 Findspots and Registered Sites

1.1.1 Stage 2 Assessment Results

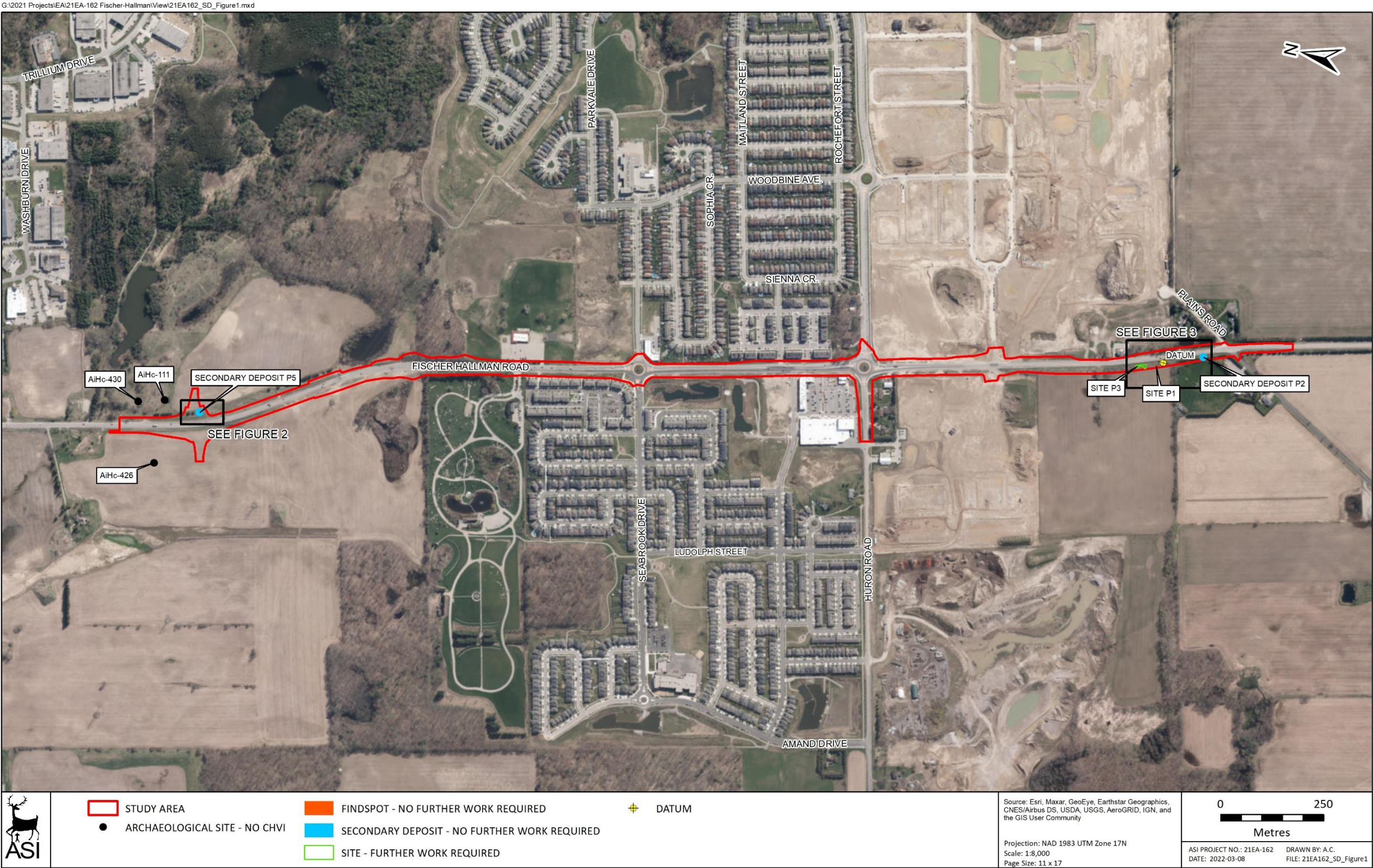


Figure 1: Detailed Location of Registered Sites within One Kilometre of the Study Area and Key of Stage 2 Assessment Results

As a result of the Stage 2 assessment for the Fischer-Hallman Road Improvements project (ASI, 2022), two non-diagnostic precontact Indigenous sites and two non-diagnostic precontact Indigenous secondary deposit findspots were identified: Site P1 (AiHc-557), Site P3 (AiHc-558), Secondary Deposit P2, and Secondary Deposit P5 (Figures 1-3).

Of the finds encountered, Site P3 (AiHc-558) exhibits cultural heritage value or interest and meets the requirements for Stage 3 site-specific assessment as per S & G Section 2.2, Standard 1.a.ii(2) and therefore requires further work. Despite a comprehensive review of the Ontario Archaeological Sites Database, Ontario's PastPortal, archaeological reports on file with the Region of Waterloo, and the latest Stage 1 report for the Fischer-Hallman Road Improvements Project (Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, 2019a), ASI could not



confirm that the area surrounding Site P3 (AiHc-558) had been previously subject to Stage 2 assessment. Unbeknownst to ASI at the time of Stage 2 survey, the area surrounding Site P3 was previously assessed by Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions (2019b: P348-0061-2019) as seen in Figure 4. During their assessment, two separate Indigenous lithic scatters were located during pedestrian survey: Location 1 and Location 2. Neither scatter met the density requirements for Stage 3 assessment, and were not recommended for further work. It is likely that the artifacts encountered as part of Site P3 (AiHc-558) are related to those documented by Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions.

The location of all finds was recorded using a Samsung Galaxy S4 tablet running Esri Collector equipped with a sub-metre Trimble Catalyst GPS. All GPS points taken were referenced to the North American Datum 1983 and projected on the Universe Transverse Mercator grid in zone 17 north.

Environmental conditions were optimal at the time of recording the GPS coordinates, with an accuracy of less than one metre of error. One off-site datum was recorded for this project: Datum 1 is represented by a hydro pole within the Fischer-Hallman Road right-of-way (Figures 1-3).

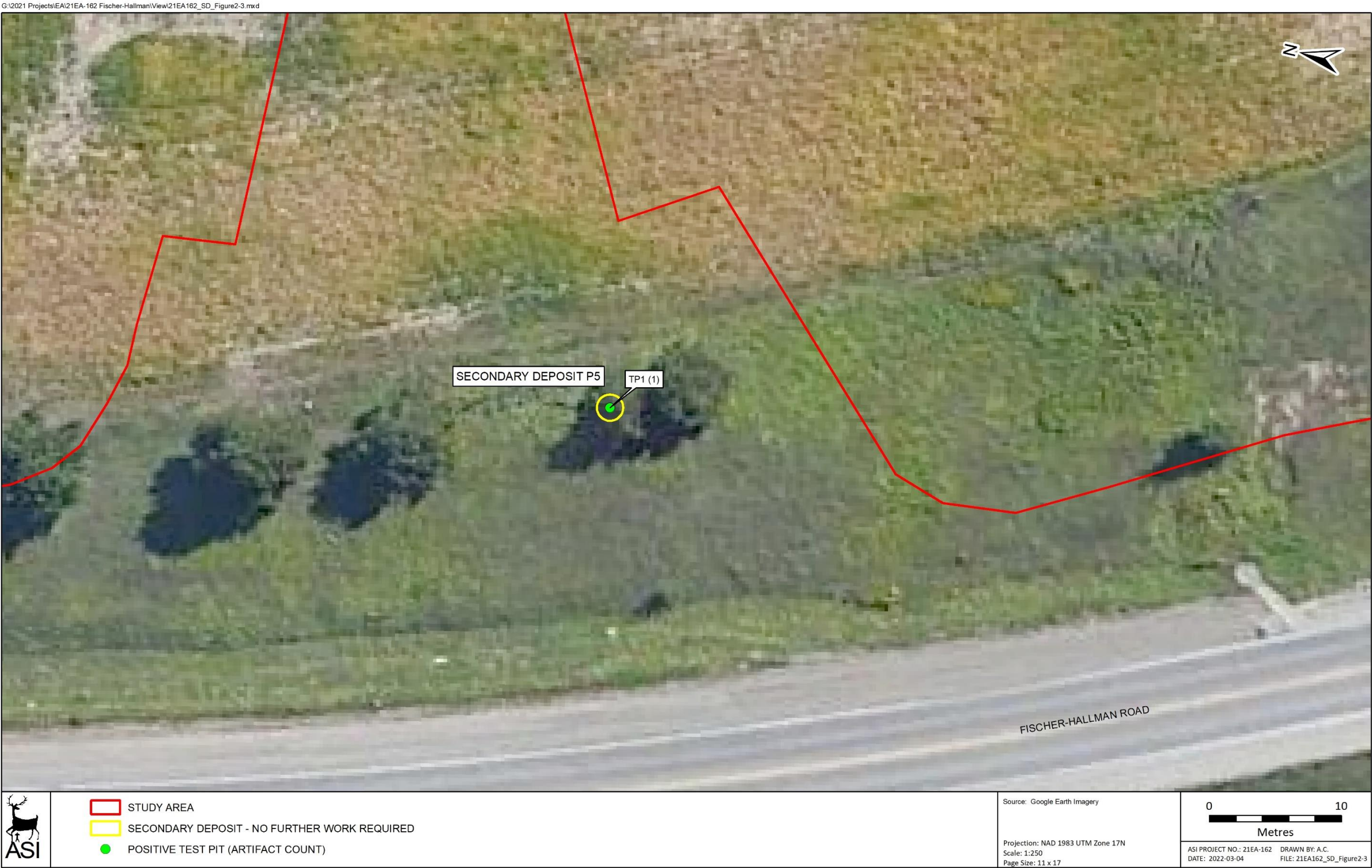


Figure 2: Detailed Site Location of Secondary Deposit P5



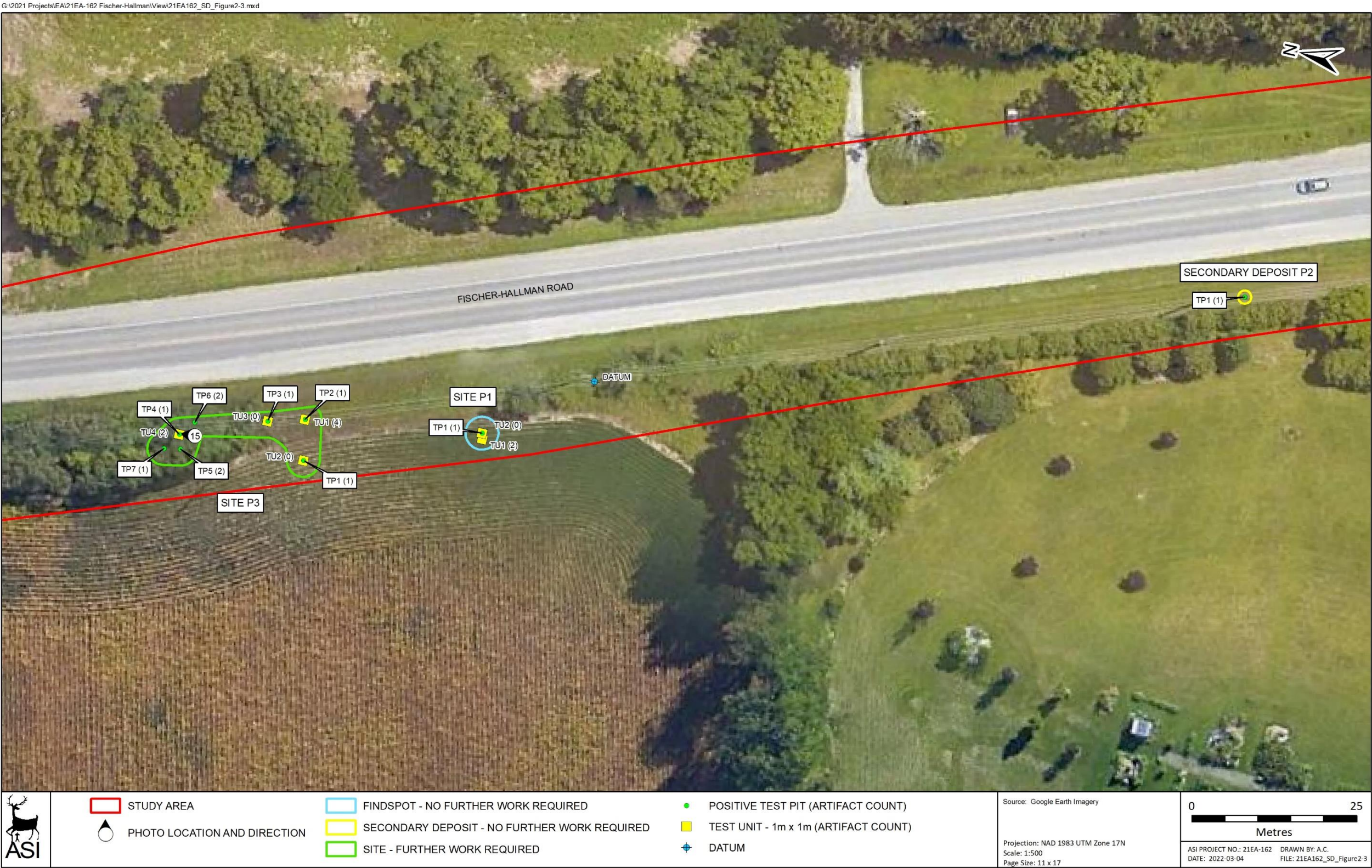


Figure 3: Detailed Site Location of Site P1 (AiHc-557), Site P3 (AiHc-558), and Secondary Deposit P2



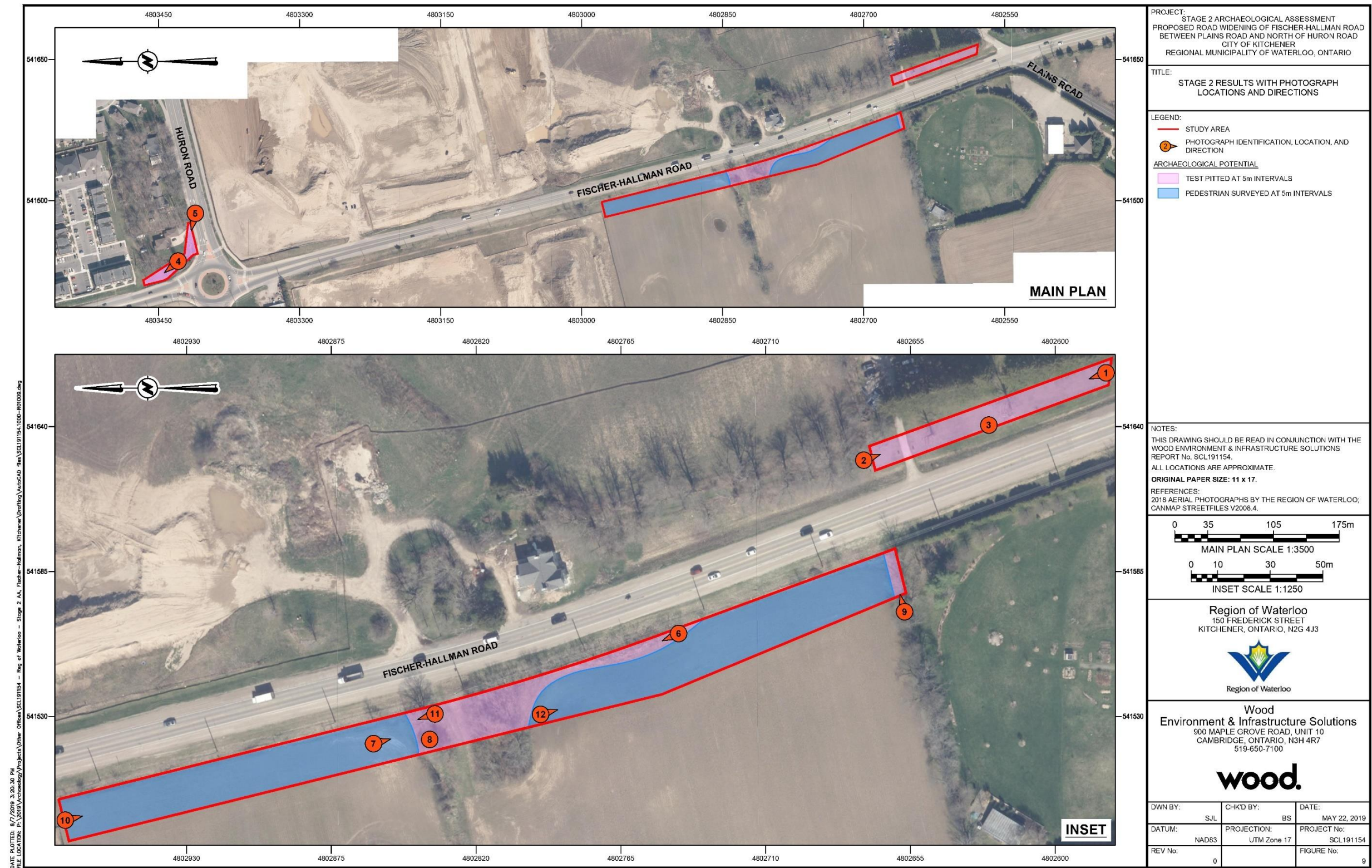


Figure 4: Previous Stage 2 Assessment Results by Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions (2019: Figure 9)
