

Construction notice update: New Dundee Road, Kitchener June–December 2025

Notice date: June 20, 2025

About the project

The Region of Waterloo is improving New Dundee Road in Kitchener. This year's work will be between Reichert Drive and Pinnacle Drive. This work includes:

- New roundabout at Robert Ferrie Drive and New Dundee Road
- New left turn lane for eastbound traffic to Pinnacle Drive from New Dundee Road
- Widening the road to add paved shoulders on the sides
- New multi-use path and pedestrian handrails on the north side of the road
- Installation of new underground sanitary sewer and watermain

Staging and Traffic Control Changes

We are working with our contractor to review potential changes to the originally planned staging of the work and the way that traffic will move through the site.

New Dundee Road and Robert Ferrie Drive will not be closed on June 23, 2025, as originally planned.

Construction will be starting on June 23, 2025, with set-up and preliminary works, but this work will take place with two-way traffic maintained at all times. There may be short-term lane closures required to complete these early works, but flag persons will be used to allow traffic to travel in both directions.

Further updates will be provided on the revised staging and traffic control in the coming weeks.
