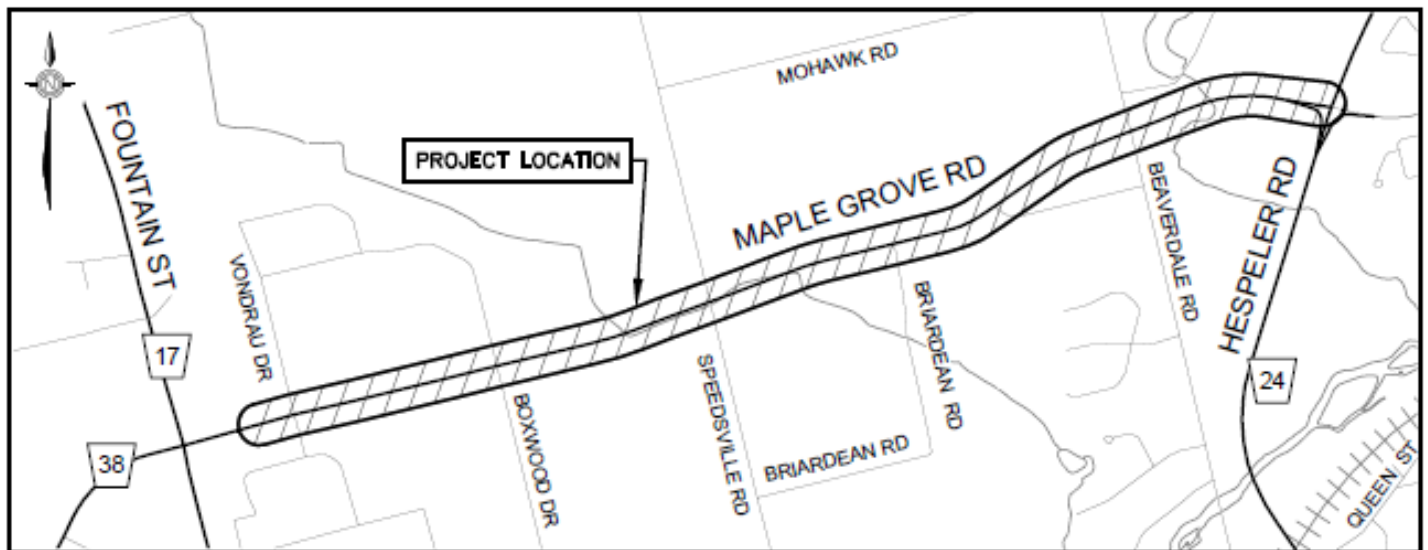


Notice of Completion
Maple Grove Road Improvements
in the City of Cambridge
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Schedule C

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo has completed a planning study in accordance with the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act* following the process for Schedule C projects under Municipal Class Environmental Assessment to address required transportation improvements on Maple Grove Road between Vondrau Drive and Hespeler Road in the City of Cambridge.



The Recommended Design Alternative includes:

- Three-metre-wide multi-use path (MUP) along both sides of the road
- Widening the road from two to four lanes of through-vehicle traffic
- A five-metre-wide raised curb, grassed median
- New curb and gutter and stormwater drainage
- New, additional street lighting

By copy of this notice, the Environmental Study Report is available for a 30-day public comment period in accordance with the requirements of a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment. Subject to comments received, and receipt of required approvals, the project can proceed to construction subject to Regional Council approval.
