

# Construction notice: Maple Grove Road, Cambridge June–December 2025

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## Hespeler Road to Beaverdale Road

Notice date: May 23, 2025

### About the project

The Region of Waterloo is starting phase one of the Maple Grove Road improvements between Hespeler Road and Beaverdale Drive in Cambridge. This work includes:

- New asphalt multi-use paths on both sides of the street and bridge
- Two new roundabouts at Hespeler Road and Beaverdale Road
- Widening from two to four lanes
- Rehabilitating Ellis (Chilligo) Creek bridge
- Stormwater and drainage improvements
- Street lighting improvements

### Timing — starts June 2025

Construction will be completed in stages starting with phase one in June until the fall. The road will reopen over winter 2025/2026.

Future work on Maple Grove Road will include multiple stages between Hespeler Road and Vondrau Drive. Phase two is expected to start in spring/summer 2026.

### Closures and lane reductions

Two-way traffic on Hespeler Road and Maple Grove Road will be maintained at all times. Lanes will be reduced on Hespeler Road, Maple Grove Road, and Fisher Mills Road.

A full closure of Fisher Mills Road at Hespeler Road is expected for four to six weeks between September and October 2025.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully in the construction zone. We request that when travelling through and around the construction zone you follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

## **Detour**

There may be periods during construction when traffic will need to travel on a gravel surface, as well as times when traffic will need to be controlled with flag persons.

Emergency Services (Police, Fire, and Paramedics) have been notified of the construction and closures to minimize any disruptions to services.

## **Property access**

Every effort will be made to maintain access to residential and business driveways in the construction area during working hours (7 a.m.–7 p.m.). Construction activities may temporarily impact access to entrances. We will provide notice of any interruption in advance as much as possible.

## **Restoration and landscaping**

If your landscaping is damaged by construction, it will be replaced/reinstated to pre-construction condition. Any sod that is replaced will be maintained for 60 days. After 60 days, all sod maintenance and watering become the responsibility of the property owner.

## **Dust, mud, and vibration**

You may notice slight vibrations from the contractor's equipment during construction. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, mud, and vibration.
