

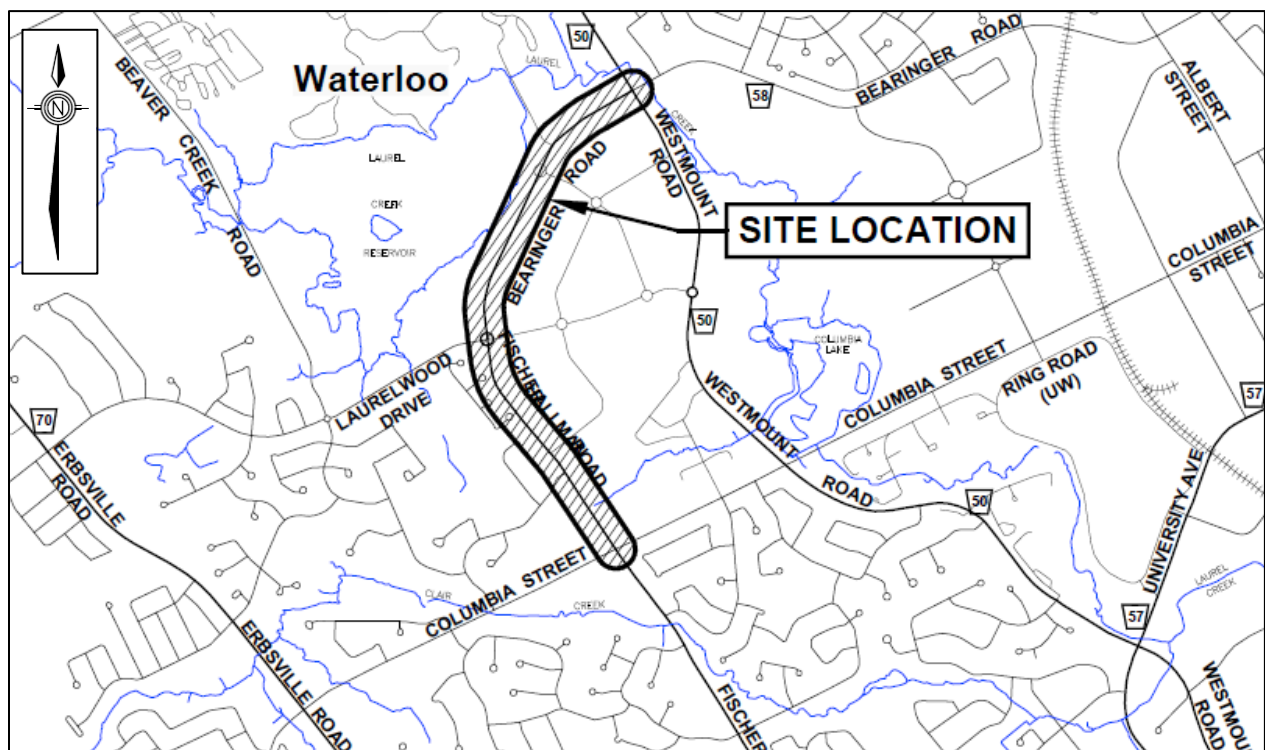

Notice of Study Commencement

Fischer-Hallman Road (Regional Road 58) Improvements Columbia Street West to Westmount Road North City of Waterloo Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, Schedule 'C'

The Regional Municipality of Waterloo is undertaking a Schedule "C" Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for improvements to the Fischer-Hallman Road (Regional Road 58) corridor from Columbia Street West to Westmount Road North in the City of Waterloo. Improvements along Fischer-Hallman Road (Regional Road 58) are being considered to improve active transportation facilities, as well as traffic capacity and operations to meet projected growth, along the corridor.



The study will be completed following the guidelines of the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment", dated October 2000 (as revised 2011), for Schedule "C" projects. The Class EA planning process will consider the potential social, economical and environmental impacts of improvements on the study area.

As part of the Class EA process, prior to any approvals, the public and stakeholders will have an opportunity to review study findings, and provide input on opportunities for improvement and associated recommendations. The first Public Consultation Centre will be held later this year to invite input regarding the study. In advance of completing the Class EA process, the public and stakeholders will also be notified of study completion and final recommendations.
