About the project

The Region of Waterloo is enhancing water services at 266 St. Andrews Street in Cambridge (Zone 3). The work includes installing a storage tank, valve chamber, installation of two new watermain within the site and an overflow connection to the existing storm system on St. Andrews Street. This project will improve water storage and pumping capacity to help meet current and future water needs in Cambridge and North Dumfries, while supporting planned regional system upgrades.

Timing — starts on or about July 21, 2026

Kingdom Construction Limited will be working on this project. Construction is expected to begin on or about July 21, 2026 and is anticipated to be finished by January 2027.

Construction activities will take place between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. Noise by-laws of the City of Cambridge will be in effect. Work outside of these hours may be required from time to time, and advance notice will be provided where possible.

Construction impacts

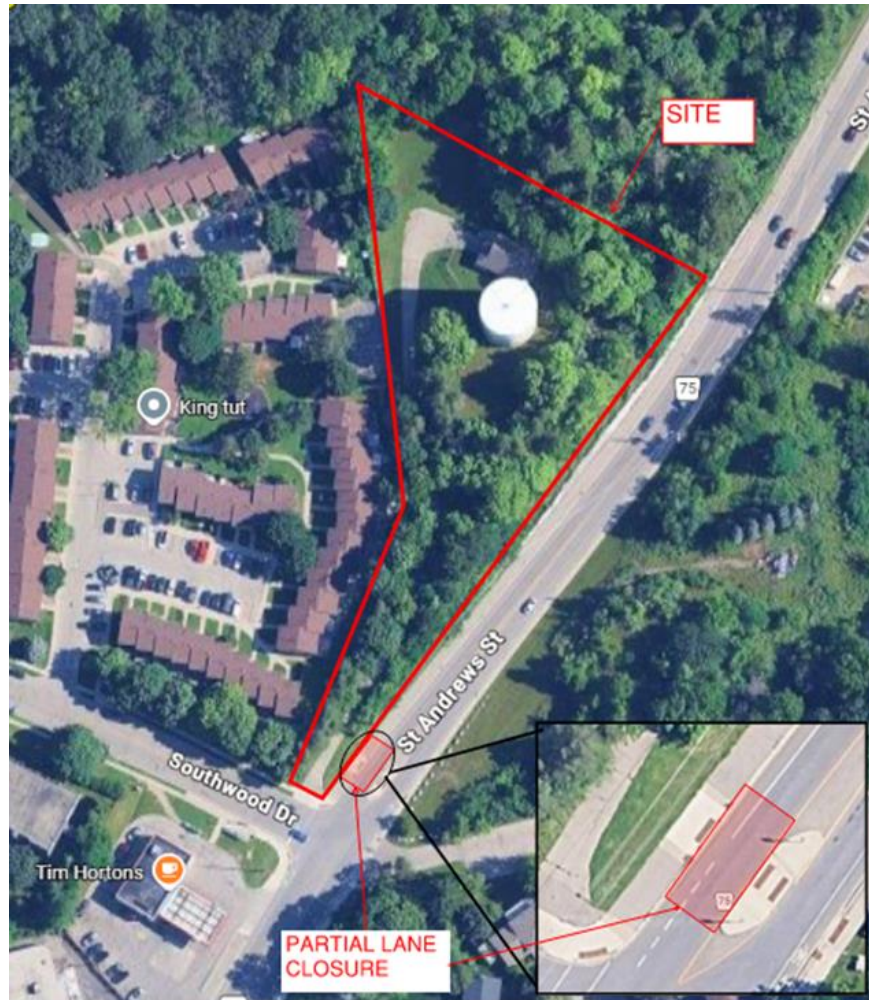
During construction, a temporary partial lane closure will be in place on St. Andrews Street near the St. Andrews Street and Southwood Drive intersection. Where lane closures are required, two-way traffic will be maintained in a single lane using flagging operations or temporary traffic signals.

Road users should expect delays, use caution when travelling through the area, and follow all posted signage for their safety and the safety of workers.

Pedestrians will continue to have access during construction. Please follow the signs posted.

Vibration, dust, mud

You may feel slight vibrations from the construction work. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from the construction including dust, mud and vibration.
