

Construction notice:

Sawmill Road/ Ebycrest Road

Township of Woolwich

August - November 2026

Sawmill Road/Bloomingdale Road and Ebycrest Road Roundabout

Notice date: August 18, 2026

About the project

The Region of Waterloo is improving the intersection at Sawmill Road/Bloomingdale Road and Ebycrest Road by replacing the existing traffic signals with a single-lane roundabout.

The project is intended to improve safety, traffic flow, and connections for people walking and cycling. The work also includes new multi-use paths, concrete curbs, a new asphalt road surface, and upgrades to underground infrastructure.

Timing

Construction will begin on or about August 24, 2026, with the main construction work expected to be completed by November 2026. Timing may be affected by weather conditions, with updates provided as needed.

Construction impacts

Bloomingdale Road and Kraft Drive will be closed to through traffic at the intersection during this Stage 1 of work. Only local access will be permitted. Two-way traffic will be maintained on Sawmill Road and Ebycrest Road.

During Stage 1, drivers can use Bridge Street and Ebycrest Road as detour routes. For more information and detour details, visit www.grt.ca/detours.

There may be periods during construction when traffic will need to travel on a gravel surface, as well as times when traffic will need to be controlled with flag persons

Emergency Services (Police, Fire, Paramedics) have been notified of the construction, closures and detours to minimize any disruptions to services.

Pedestrian access

The pedestrian route in this area will remain accessible during the project. Please follow the signs and marked pathways when walking through the construction area.

Property and business access

All businesses in the construction area will remain open and accessible during construction. Every effort will be made to maintain access to residential and business driveways in the construction area throughout the construction period. Temporary access restrictions may be required to accommodate construction activities. Advance notice will be provided where possible.

Please plan for some delays and travel carefully in the construction zone. When driving or walking through and around the construction zone, follow and obey the construction traffic signage for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

Pre-construction property assessment

Residents and businesses in the construction area will be contacted by a staff member from Englobe to conduct a free pre-construction condition assessment. This will document the building's existing condition including any cracks and visible structural or cosmetic defects of the exterior and interior of the property.

If property owners/tenants suspect damage as a result of construction activities, the information for this assessment will help resolve the issue.

Waste collection changes

Waste collection will be maintained throughout construction.

Restoration and landscaping

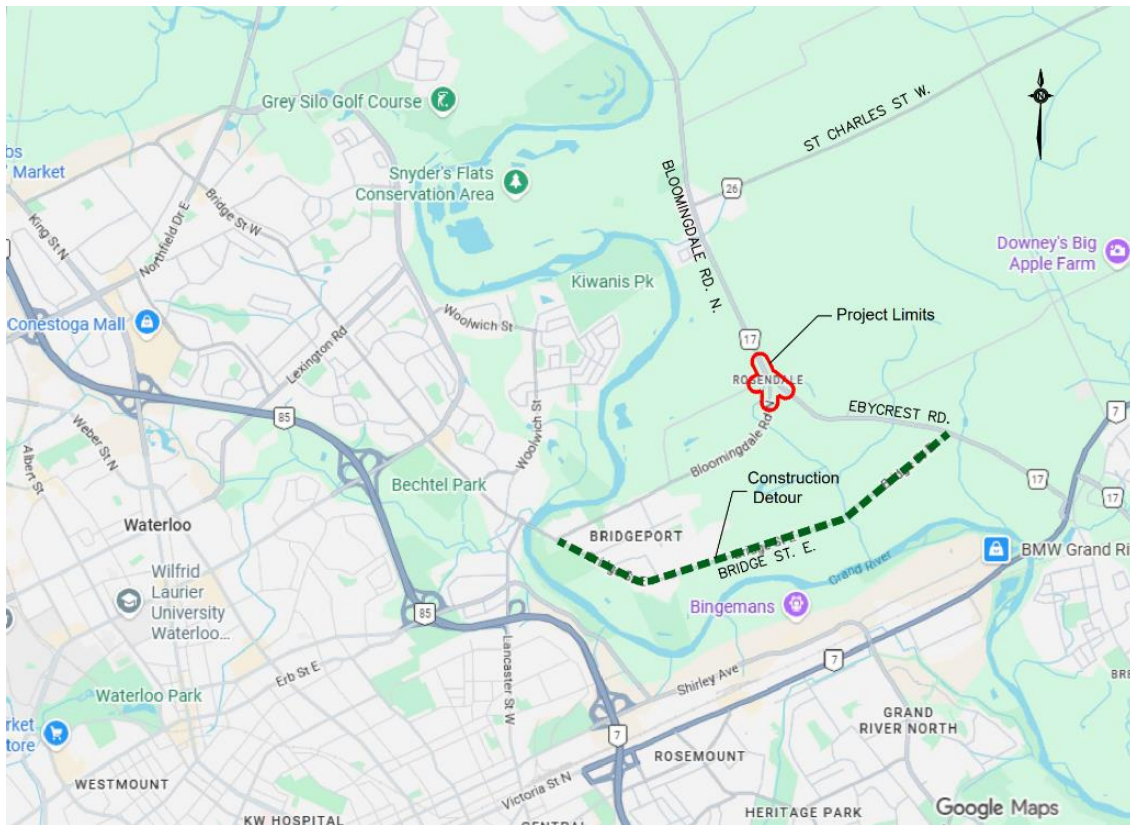
If your driveway or landscaping is damaged by construction, we will replace/reinstate it to pre-construction condition. We will take care of any sod that is replaced for 60 days. After 60 days, all sod maintenance and watering become the responsibility of the property owner.

Dust, mud and vibration

You may notice slight vibrations from the contractor's equipment during construction. All efforts will be made to minimize adverse impacts from construction including dust, mud and vibration.
